\$20 Million Future Ready Funds

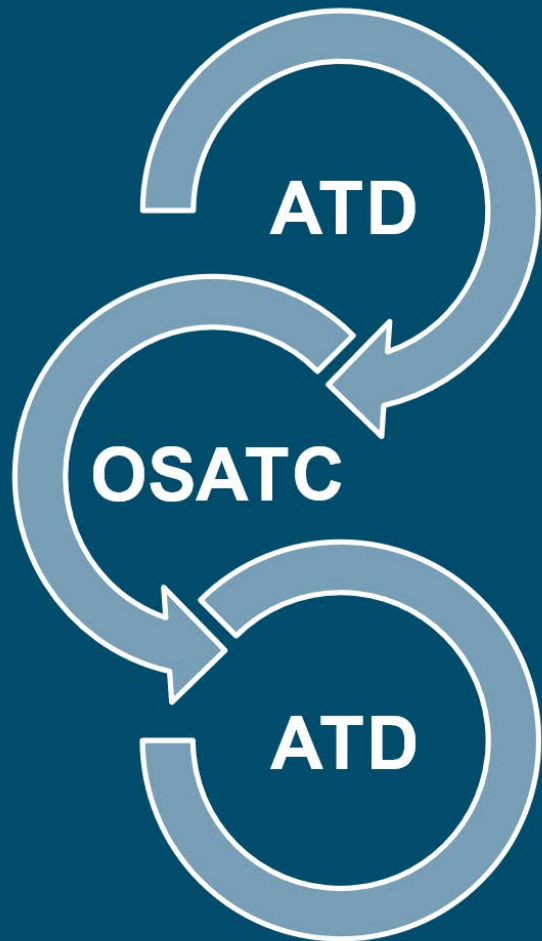
\$18.9 Million in Grant Awards

3-4 Rounds of Funding

Round 2 Funding Cap - \$10 Million



Apprenticeship in Oregon



- Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI) – Apprenticeship and Training Division (ATD)
 - Assists in development and registration
 - Makes recommendations to OSATC
 - Equal Employment Opportunity in Registered Apprenticeship
 - Technical Assistance for Operations
- Oregon State Apprenticeship and Training Council (OSATC)
 - Governing authority
 - Enforcement

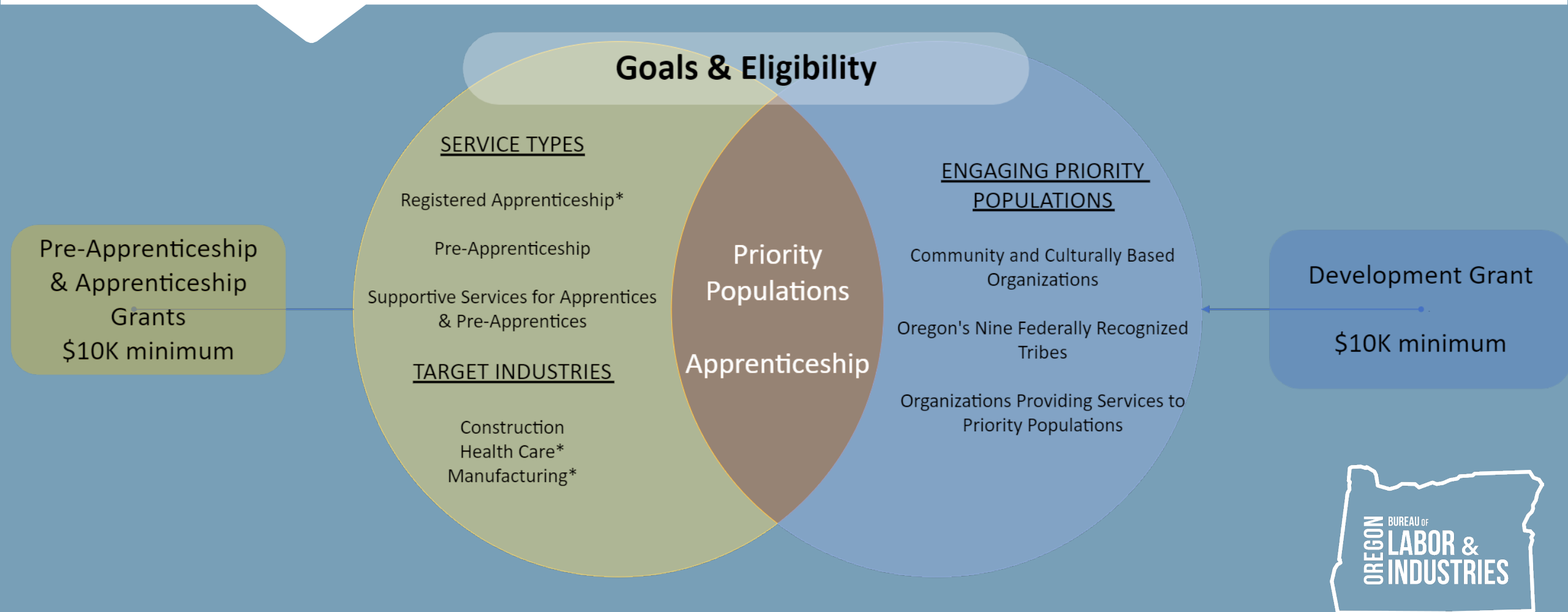

Required: Budget Form, Logic Model

Letters of Support, if required



Application Logic Model – each industry

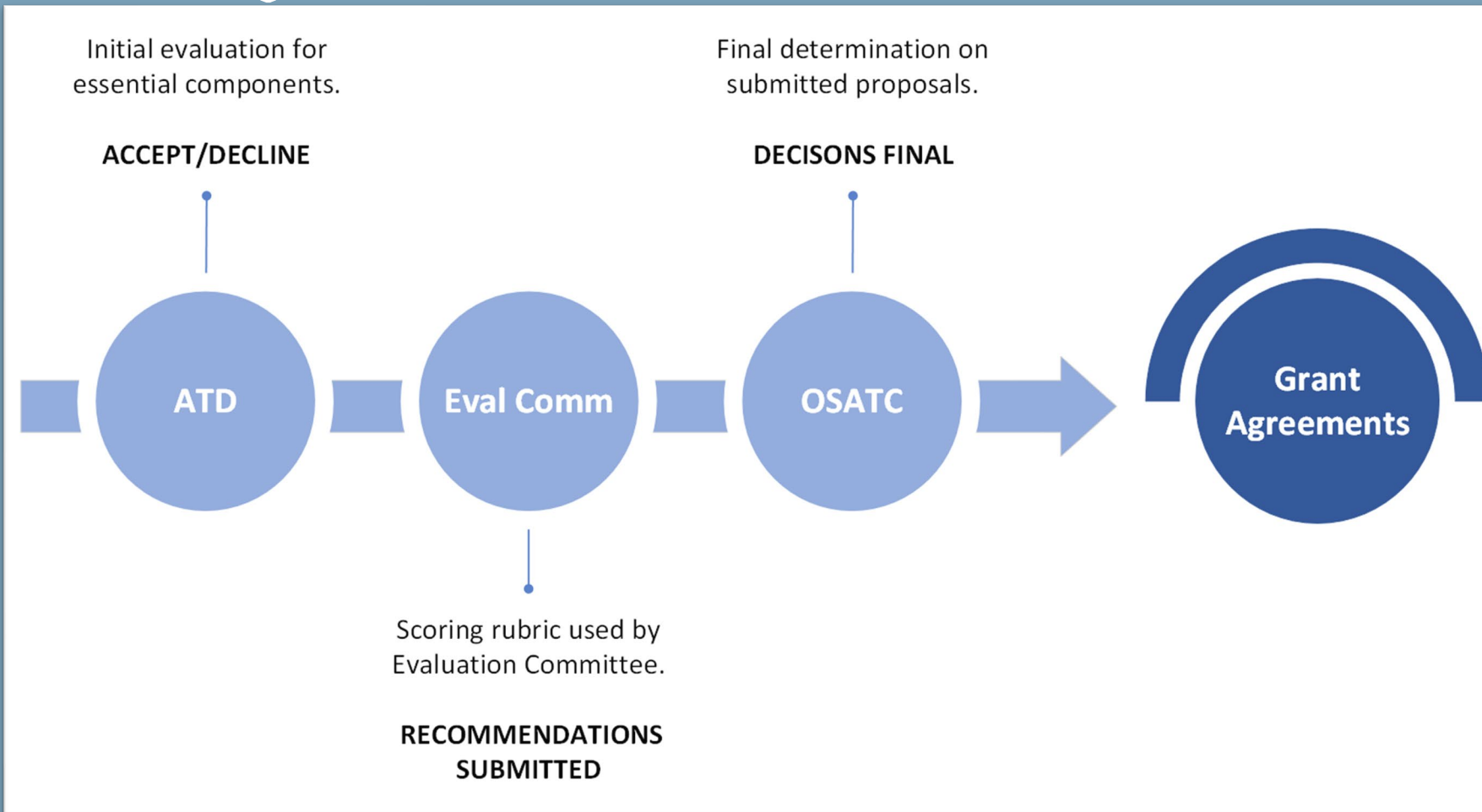

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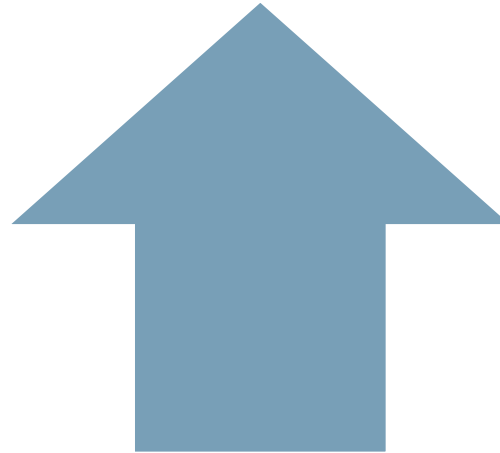

Top Application Tips...

1. Pre-Apprenticeship? Must have identified RAP w/support letter
2. “Key Partner” listed? Must have support letter
3. Clear & specific outreach strategies for each Priority Population?
4. Student Support Services? Must be a separate line item in budget
5. Student wages? Not permitted, but stipends are if need well documented
6. Budget scalable? Explain how you can scale your budget if the full amount is not granted.

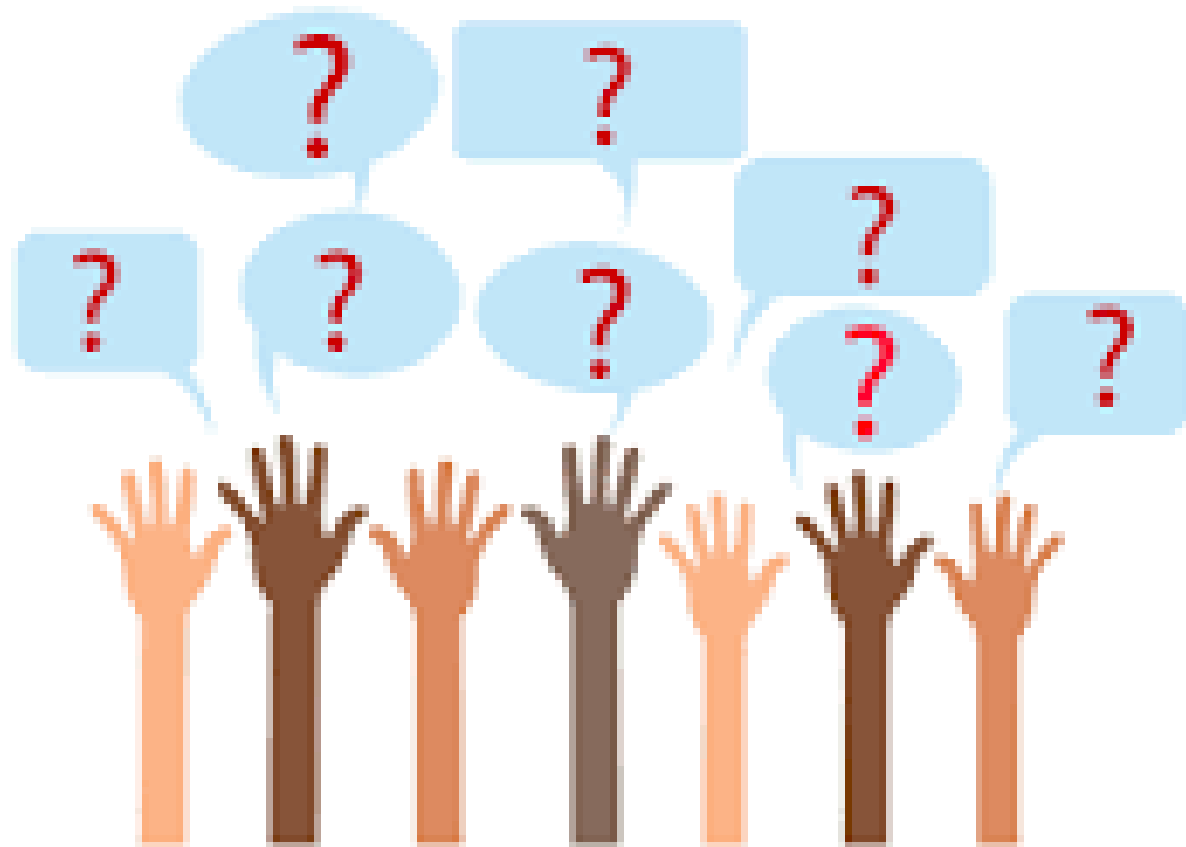
