Virtual Teams Meeting

The OSATC will convene in Executive Session pursuant to ORS 192.660(2)(f) to consider information or records that are exempt by law from public inspection. OSATC will also convene in Executive Session pursuant to ORS 192.660(2)(h) to consult with legal counsel concerning the legal rights and duties of a public body regarding current litigation or litigation likely to be filed. No final actions will be taken or final decisions rendered in this Executive Session by the OSATC.

Pursuant to Oregon Revised Statute 192.660(4), representatives of the news media will be allowed to attend Executive Session. Representatives of the news media are specifically directed not to report on or otherwise disclose any of the deliberations or anything said about these subjects during the executive session, except to state the general subject of the session as previously announced. A representative of the news media will be excluded from executive sessions held to discuss litigation with legal counsel if they are a party to the litigation or an employee, agent or contractor of a news media organization that is a party.
