BOLI and Oregon Legislature agree to try conciliation in civil rights complaint

The Oregon Bureau of Labor and Industries announced Friday that representatives of the state Legislature have requested to enter a conciliation process in hopes of resolving the ongoing civil rights complaint against the assembly.

As authorized by ORS 659A.840, BOLI intends to pursue mediation with the Legislature and intends that this matter be overseen by a neutral, third-party mediator.

While mediation and related communications are confidential, BOLI has invited attorneys for any aggrieved person to participate in the process, with the goal of finding a satisfactory resolution to the alleged discriminatory practices for all involved.

BOLI intends to schedule the first mediation meeting by the end of January.
