

Supplement 5— Request for Temporary License



Temporary licenses are for applicants for conditional speech-language pathology or initial audiology licensure, who have completed all degree requirements but the university is not scheduled to confer the degree before employment begins. In these rare instances the Board will accept a letter that **must come directly from the university registrar**, documenting that the applicant has **completed all degree requirements and has been approved to receive the degree**.

Complete this form in full and attach it to your SLP/AUD application form. The fee for the temporary license is \$100, in addition to the application and regular license fees. The temporary license will expire after 90 days.

We must receive your transcript *no more than 60 days* after the temporary license is issued or you will be assessed a \$100 delinquent fee. After verifying the transcript, we will upgrade the temporary license to a conditional SLP or regular AUD license.
