Updated on the 2025-27 Fiscal Summary.

Sean Riesterer, Central Services Manager

Financial Analyst / Budget Analyst position – Devi Meneses started April 20th and onboarded quickly with immediate engagement and impact for agency financial and budget development. She is now CCB's primary financial and budget analyst and agency coordinator for state budget processing.

2027-29 Budget Development – Oregon's 2027-29 Budget and Legislative Concept process kicked off officially March 17. Phase 2 began a series of Pricing and Drafting deadlines over the months ahead, notably for CCB with completed steps since April board meeting:

April 30 – Draft Agency IT Readiness workbook due – *Submitted*

May 1 – Current Service Level (CSL) workbook due – *Submitted*

May 29 – CSL information and audit transmittal due – *Submitted, Audit passed*

June 26 – Agency Request Budget (ARB) and audit transmittal due – *in process*

June 30 – Updated Agency IT Readiness workbook due – *in process*

July 31 – Agency Request Budget (ARB) narrative due – *in process*
 August 26 – State of Oregon September Revenue Forecast – *to be monitored for impact*
 October-November – Phase 3 - Governor’s Recommended Build Out
 Fiscal Year End June 30, 2026 – In collaboration with CCB’s Program Accountant from DAS Shared Financial Services, staff are proactively processing accounts payable and year-end checklists to support an efficient fiscal year-end close.

Information Technology Status Update:

An annual IT Strategic Plan Progress Report for 2026 has been prepared and posted publicly on CCB’s website, highlighting current status and significant progress in the past year.
 We continue to explore improvement in IT workflows, user support and agency engagement as we are preparing to facilitate agency-wide system modernization and future new system implementation.
 Enterprise Security Office (ESO) reports 100% systems scanned, 0% vulnerability detected (June 2)

System Modernization / Licensing System Replacement (Project Status Report attached)

CCB’s RFP evaluation team evaluated 15 qualified vendor RFP submissions and convened with State of Oregon Procurement on May 20, 2026, to review combined scoring results from the Round 1 Evaluation process and potential next steps.

Preparing for Round 2 evaluation CCB leadership has led the RFP evaluation team through a series of collaborative exercises and discussions leading to a selection of 5 vendors for further evaluation. In the coming weeks Round 2 evaluation will begin with a focused set of initial questions to be answered by each vendor in preparation for live interviews with each vendor remotely. Round 2 interviews are tentatively planned to be scheduled in early July, concluding by mid-July.

Round 2 evaluation is designed to lead CCB to further clarity and identification of a final set of vendors for deeper evaluation through onsite interviews and solution demonstrations to ultimately select a vendor.

Fiscal Year End June 30, 2026 – CCB Central Services staff in collaboration with CCB's Program Accountant from DAS Shared Financial Services proactively worked towards an efficient June, Q4 and fiscal year-end close July 17th followed by a Month 13 period for final entries close August 14th.

Information Technology Status Update:

IT is working with State Data Center (SDC) and Enterprise Information Services (EIS) to enhance CCB's data backup capabilities. Minimizing the risk of potential data loss between backups is the goal.

CCB participated in a Cyber event tabletop exercise (TTX) August 12th hosted by EIS and State Cyber Command (SCC) to practice realistic cyber incident responses in a structured collaboration with other agencies focused on optimal decision-making and use of available resources.

System Modernization / Licensing System Replacement (Project Status Report attached)

CCB leadership has worked with DAS Procurement to lead the RFP evaluation team through a series of collaborative exercises and discussions leading to selection of 5 vendors (from original 15 proposals) for further evaluation. Round 2 evaluations will include live vendor interviews and demonstrations expected to be scheduled in September.

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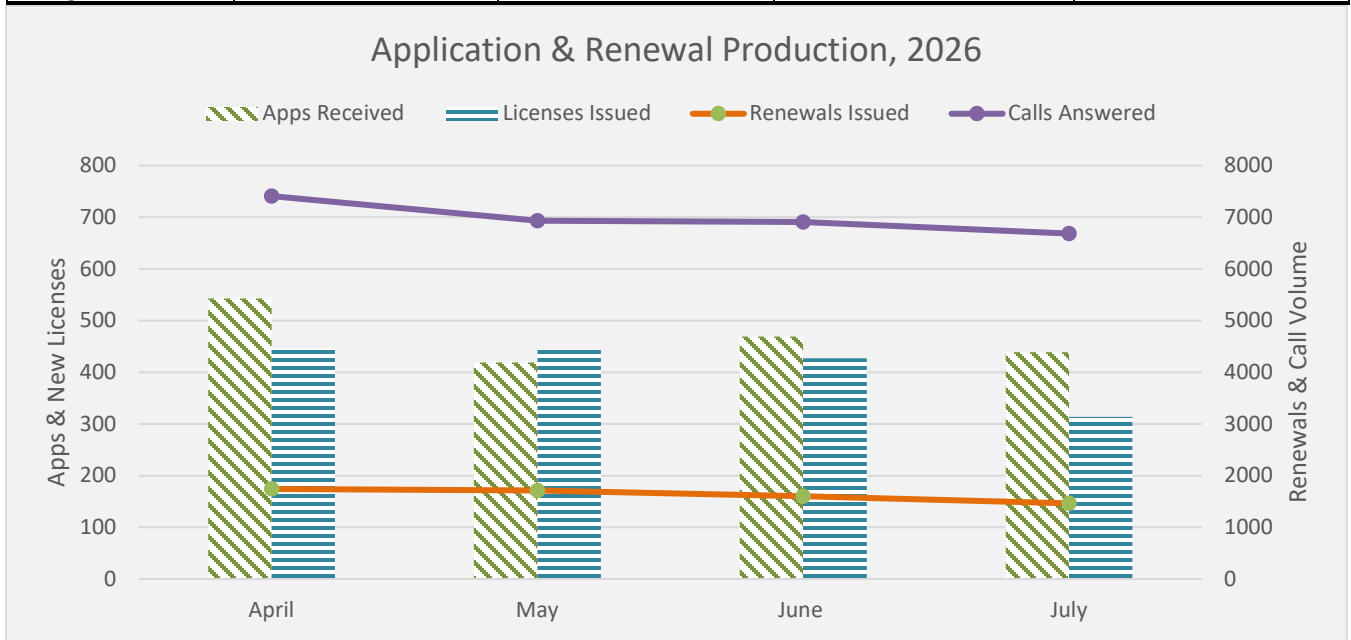

Update

The Education section unrolled a summer webinar series to homeowners, including a webinar on Wildfire Hazard Mitigation and a webinar on Door to Door Sales. The Education section is also working on communication with public records requestors to streamline public records requests, which produces an increasing amount of work for the section. The Education section has added a new FAQ to the website, created new templates for communicating with requestors, and has created new internal processes for streamlining and organizing public record requests.

The Education section is also working on the fall schedule. Summer is a time of year when the demand for live webinars with contractors seems to decrease, but the demand picks back up in the fall and winter. We'll be unrolling a schedule soon to meet the demand.

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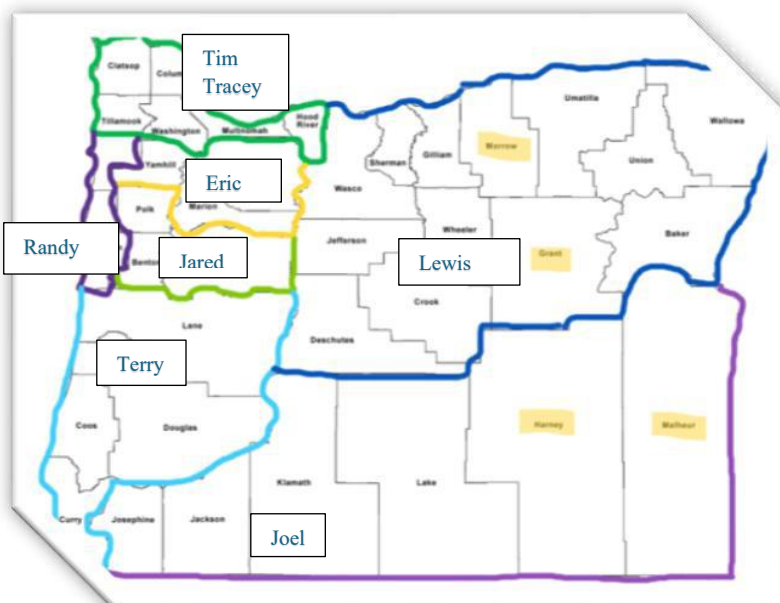

Requested Action

Ratify 2027-2029 agency request budget (ARB) for consideration as part of the 2027-2029 Governor's Request Budget.

Background

Due to actions taken during the 2023-2025 biennium, the agency achieved a degree of relative budget stability. As described below, this has been somewhat short-lived. The license fee increase adopted in 2024 went into full effect by July 2025. At the time of adoption, the board identified the following priorities:

- **Address the structural budget deficit.**
- **Maintain existing service levels.**
- **Ensure viability of modernization efforts** (replacement of 1990's-era license system).

Unfortunately, the steadily increasing rate of labor cost and associated service and supply costs continue to be an impediment. The agency is proposing a 2027-2029 ARB that we believe is a responsible approach to maintaining adequate service levels while also ensuring the viability of the critical modernization project.

2025-2027 Agency Request Budget (ARB)

The ARB is developed by the agency, following DAS guidelines. The ARB is reviewed by the DAS Chief Financial Office (CFO) staff and Governor's Office staff. The next step in the process will be the Governor's Recommended Budget followed by legislative consideration next year. This budget continues the key priorities adopted as part of the 2025-2027 budget and makes mid-stream adjustments in order to ensure the viability of the modernization project.

The foundation of the ARB is the Current Service Level (CSL) budget, which includes all current funding with adjustments for inflation. Adjustments to the CSL budget take the form of Policy Option Packages (POPs). The 2027-2029 ARB includes three POPs:

- **Package 070 Revenue shortfall POP:** This package eliminates two positions in order to retain sufficient reserves to carry the license project forward. Again, steadily increasing labor cost inflation is the primary driver. The two positions are vacant and include one management position and staff-level position. The agency believes this is a prudent move that supports project viability while balancing minimal reduction in service levels.

- **License System Replacement POPs:** The additional two POPs simply carry forward the projected costs of the license system replacement. When an IT project is expected to have costs occur across two biennia, the total project cost is moved forward with inflation applied. The two POPs separate implementation costs and maintenance and hosting costs:

Additional Notes

Two additional considerations bear mention at this stage of budget development:

- **2025-2027 Adjustments:** The agency anticipates at least one and possibly two adjustments to our 2025-2027 budget. These adjustments may roll into the 2027-2029 budget adopted during the legislative session next spring. These possible adjustments include:
 - **Full SDC Cost:** The agency will seek an adjustment of \$180,000 in limitation to cover the full cost of services provided by the SDC. The initial cost estimate was based on services for a partial biennium and did not reflect the full cost of service. This cost is partially offset by the elimination of the CIO/IT manager position noted above.
 - **Attorney General Billings:** As discussed at previous meetings, the agency has incurred a significant increase in billings from the Department of Justice (DOJ). This increase is based on volume of activity, not increase in rate of pay. The increase in activity is driven by an increase in demand for hearings, which is outside the control of the agency. We understand that other agencies are experiencing a similar increase in demand for DOJ services. Based on our current projection, the agency would end the biennium approximately \$135,000 above our biennial projection. It may be necessary to seek

additional limitation to cover this increase for the 2025-2027 biennium. The amount of potential adjustment to the 2027-2029 budget would also be determined at that time.

- **Potential for fee increase during the 2027-2029 biennium:** While the agency is not proposing a fee increase as part of the budget development process, we are noting the potential need for increased revenue during the biennium. The key variables that will drive whether such an action will become necessary include the rate of increase in cost and the degree of improved efficiency post system implementation.
During the adoption process for the prior increase, the board and the industry highlighted a desire for more incremental increases, on a more predictable cycle. The prior increase was a significant increase due in part to the 14-year gap between fee adjustments. If an increase is warranted it would be expected to be incremental and the approximate 5-year gap between adjustments would be in line with the normal duration for Oregon boards and commissions similar to CCB.

Conclusion

Please review the attached annotated ARB and consider approving it to submit to DAS and the Governor.
