F. PUBLIC COMMENT:

G. AGENCY REPORTS:

Chris Huntington, Agency Administrator provided an update regarding the agency opening back up to the public. The Governor has pushed the September 1 reopening date out with no specific date at this time. The agency continues to work a plan of what that will look like when it does open back up. Also mentioned was the statewide executive branch mandate for the COVID-19 vaccine, the deadline is now October 18, 2021. The updated budget report was presented, discussed and will be emailed to the board after the meeting.

Dana Zeimantz, Licensing Manager reported there has been an increase in new license applications monthly which is the biggest licensing challenge. The average turn around last quarter was 16 days and they are now reporting closer to 14 days. The goal is to turn them around in 7-10 days. License cards are now being printed offsite and the survey is now electronically being sent out.

Noel Magee, Information Technology Manager reported that IT has been very busy assisting with the licensing cards being moved to the print plant. Additionally the support for in office networking network was moved to DAS EIS. PCI compliance is another project that is being worked on and is moving smoothly. Email phishing will go live on October 1, 2021, the open data initiative is also coming an example of that would be a license list publicly. Security end point data gathering has also been completed, this determines where we have holes across the enterprise.

Leslie Culpepper, Communication/Education Manager advised the homeowner survey for the KPMs did happen this year and there was a 54% response rate of homeowners who are aware of the CCB. This survey is done every 2 years. The survey was online and encompassed 800 homeowners versus 500 from past surveys. This last year of challengers related to in person classes being cancelled has increased the reach the education section has with webinars and online trainings for contractors.

Stan Jessup, Enforcement Manager noted that there was a need to replace a couple of Field Investigators due to retirement and a resignation. Those positions were filled in a dual capacity of field investigation and mediation which has spread more mediation capacity across the state. The memo included that quarterly reports and other statistical data.






Approximately 54 percent of Oregon homeowners are aware of the CCB. This is a ten point increase over 2019 and is based on a scientific survey of 828 Oregon homeowners conducted in June 2021.

Factors Affecting Results

COVID-19 has disrupted many traditional outreach activities, and the agency has adapted to the online and virtual environment to reach homeowners where they are. Outreach efforts continue through webinars, press releases, mass emails, joint publications with other agencies, PSAs and radio and television interviews. In previous years, the agency's primary outreach focus included home building and improvement shows. When large groups are once again permitted, home shows may remain an important avenue of outreach. However, there are indications a declining percentage of homeowners attend these events. To accommodate, the agency has been activtely seeking new avenues to reach homeowners through agency partners that include other state and local government agencies, stakeholders and contractors themselves.


Factors Affecting Results

How Are We Doing


The agency was well under the target maximum for FY 2021 (7/1/20-6/30/21). For FY 2021 the agency achieved .27 percent.

Factors Affecting Results

The agency's mediation service offers parties alternative ways to resolve disputes involving minimal cost to complainants. By doing so, contractors who may not be able to pay a large debt have the opportunity to take care of the dispute in a way that preserves their license. Because of the 2011 changes to the Dispute Resolution Services, process complainants are more likely to settle disputes through mediation without going to court. Because a high percentage of the claimants that do go to court use the Small Claims Courts, the contractor's bond is able to act as a backup when the contractor can't pay a judgement award.


In FY 2021 (7/1/20-6/30/21), CCB remains under the target limit of 40 average days to resolution.


The agency missed its target for FY 2021 (7/1/20-6/30/21) by one day.

Factors Affecting Results

The current program offers mediation to the parties in an attempt to reconcile the dispute. If the parties cannot come to an agreement, the complaining party must file a complaint in court. If a judgment is awarded, the complaining party may file the judgment with the agency seeking payment from the contractor's bond. One factor that contributes to the timeliness of our services is the time it takes for a court or arbitration to issue a ruling for parties that chose to file actions. This is not within the scope of the agency's control and with courts closed for long periods during the pandemic, it will take time to resolve the length of time to resolution.




The Licensing section consistently enjoys a high level of satisfaction with customers, and staff members work hard to keep it that way.



Subject: Licensing Report

- August and September New Application records are approximately the same as seen in August/September 2020. The call center averaged 337 calls per day for the last quarter.
- Licensing has begun a pilot project to incorporate background screening staff in the new application process. Currently Licensing is documenting both the screening and application data entry processes and has assigned additional data entry staff in preparation for process improvement. Status = on deck
 - The expected results are more streamlined agency communication with applicants, faster licensure and increased compliance with worker's compensation requirements.
- Updated License Application project update: continuing to revise content and order of application sections to eliminate common pitfalls for contactors. Status = on deckExpected outcomes are:
 - Reduced volume and length of phone calls regarding new applications
 - o Increased satisfaction with new application process
 - Shorter turnaround due to fewer incomplete or incorrect applications
 - More efficient data entry of new applications
- New Licensing project includes email reminders for CCB contractors for license renewal and general liability insurance expirations. Status = Email design and scripts have been completed and are ready for review by agency director. Target outcomes are:
 - Increase timely license renewal
 - o Increase contractor knowledge of portal use for continuing education and online renewal
 - Increase contractor knowledge of steps to renew
 - Reduce cost of postage for sending paper reminders
 - Decrease license expirations
 - Increase timely submission of insurance certificates
 - Decrease administrative suspensions due to lack of insurance
 - o Decrease cost of sending certified mail for insurance suspension notification
 - o Provide and promote insurance agent use of electronic portal

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- Decrease staff labor dedicated to resolving expired licenses and suspended licenses over the phone and via email.
- o Increase positive outcomes for contractors related to CCB business

The Education section released an edition of the homeowner newsletter in October and a Toolbox newsletter in August. Both newsletters are available in email and PDF forms.

The homeowner Tools and Tips newsletter was created in August 2020. It has been released (approximately) quarterly since that time. In Aug 2020, the homeowner newsletter had a distribution of 6,481. Since that time, Education section has worked hard to promote the homeowner newsletter. After reconfiguring the sign up on the website to make it more prominent, advertising the newsletter to realtors and contractors, and promoting the sign up in multiple places on the website, the most recent newsletter had a distribution of 10,244.

CCB, DCBS and DOJ recently collaborated on a new Disaster Scams brochure. We're printing copies for distribution and will be notifying various organizations that help disaster relief victims. We have also put the brochure on the website.

Submitting Your Insurance Certificate to the CCB is Easier with E-Proof

Does your insurance agent submit your proof of insurance to the CCB? Late or forgotten insurance renewals are one of the more common reasons for license suspensions. Did you know CCB can process your certificates of insurance in as little as 1-2 business days if your agent uses the E-Proof system?

E-Proof for insurance agents is an easier, faster way to submit a contractor's proof of insurance coverage to the CCB. E-Proof allows insurance agents to submit insurance certificate information via CCB's website portal.

Certificates of insurance sent to the CCB via E-Proof are typically processed in 1-2 business days, versus paper documents which can take up to 7-10 business days.

Next time you talk to your insurance agent, mention CCB's E-Proof system. To subscribe and access E-Proof, insurance agents can complete and submit the E-Proof application found on CCB's website at www.oregon.gov/CCB/licensing/Pages/forms-fees.aspx.

This service is free of charge. Upon CCB's receipt of completed E-Proof application, agents will receive a link and login information at their email address, which will allow them to submit insurance certification via CCB's website portal for agents.

Did you know you can check your continuing education credits online?

We get many questions from residential contractors who want to renew their license and don't know how many hours of continuing education credit they've already completed. You don't have to call the CCB to find out how many hours of CE you've completed – you can look it up yourself! Here's how:

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A lead license is required if you're bidding on pre-1978 homes

Homes and child-occupied buildings such as daycare centers, preschools and kindergarten rooms constructed before 1978 are presumed to have lead paint unless testing shows otherwise.

Contractors cannot bid on renovation projects for pre-1978 homes until they have completed an approved training class and obtain a Lead-Based Paint Renovation License.

"Renovation" means modifying any structure or part of a structure that disturbs more than:

- Six square feet of painted surface per room for interior work.
- 20 square feet of painted surface for exterior work.

This includes projects involving flooring, windows, gutters, siding, and painting. Window replacement is considered renovation.

Why get your lead license?

There are many reasons to get your lead license.

- Avoid fines. CCB fines for lead-based paint violations run between \$1,000 and \$5,000, but EPA violations can be upwards of \$30,000 per day until remediated.
- Protect clients. Individuals seeking a lead license must learn lead-safe practices that protect clients from potential exposure to toxic lead dust.
- Claim continuing education credit. Your <u>lead based</u> paint credits can be claimed as continuing education credit for your CCB license.

How do I get licensed?

At least one owner or employee of a contractor's business must complete the eight-hour Renovation, Repair and Painting (RRP) training from an accredited provider.

- The Oregon Health Authority maintains a <u>training calendar</u>. It also has a <u>list of accredited training providers</u>
- You can also call 971-673-0440 or email lead.program@state.or.us.
- This initial certification is valid for five years. Before your certification expires, you must take a four-hour refresher course from an Oregon Health Authority approved provider. If your initial certificate expires before you take the refresher course, you must take the full eight-hour course again.

Applying for a lead renovator license

Once you complete the initial training, apply to the CCB for a Lead-Based Paint Renovation license.

Here is the license application. The fee is \$50.

Who Needs Classes?

Any contractor - commercial or residential - can take CCB's 3 hour webinars.

Residential contractors are required to take 3 hours of CCB laws, regulations and business practices (LRB) classes every two years in order to renew their license. These new webinars fulfill that requirement. Residential contractors only need to take this class one time every two years to renew their license, and will not receive additional credits for taking the class more than once.

A message from OHA: Testing paint for lead under the RRP rule

Contractors that perform renovation work on pre-1978 housing can either presume that lead-based paint is present and follow required lead-safe work practices, or they can test surfaces for lead-based paint prior to performing any work on those surfaces. Options for testing include either collecting a paint chip sample for analysis at an accredited laboratory, or using an EPA-recognized lead test kit. These tests must be performed by a certified renovator that has completed a Renovation Repair and Painting (RRP) training and received a Lead-Based Paint Renovation license from the CCB.

If an approved test kit is used, state and federal rules require that the kit manufacturer's instructions be followed in order for the results to be valid. The **3M LeadCheck and D-Lead** test kits (the only approved lead test kits available to Oregon contractors) are single-use only. Extending the use of these kits to test multiple building components will invalidate those results since this practice is not found within the manufacturer's instructions. For example, using cotton swabs to test additional components with the remaining fluid in a used **3M LeadCheck** swab is not allowed under the RRP rule since this practice is not in the kit's instructions. Likewise, the **D-Lead** test kit instructions tell the user to "[n] ever put more or less than one entire sample into the bottle" of testing solution. The test result for each building component must be documented on the <u>Test Kit Documentation Form</u> or a similar document that is provided to the client no more than 30 days after the work is completed.

A negative determination from an approved test kit or a paint chip sample means that renovations affecting that specific component are exempt from the RRP work practice requirements. Any building components that remain untested but will be affected by the renovation must be treated as lead-based paint, even if they are similar to those that were tested.

For more information, please read the applicability section of EPA's Code of Federal Regulations for Residential Property Renovation found in 40 CFR 745.82. EPA's <u>frequent questions website</u> is also a helpful resource to clarify aspects of the RRP rule.

It's Fall Y'all! 7 Home Maintenance Tasks to Prepare for Cold Weather

Time to perform that annual home inspection! If your home needs repair, it's important to identify potential maintenance issues that could lead to damage, and hire a contractor before rain and snow fall.

- 1. Look for cracked or peeling caulking or weather-stripping around window sills, door frames, siding gaps, trim, then repair or replace if missing or damaged.
- 2. Check roof for damaged, loose or missing shingles. Check flashing around roof stacks, vents, skylights, and chimneys and in roof valleys for missing or loose flashing. Repair or replace if necessary.
- 3. Check for water stains in the roof of the attic and in the exterior overhangs or soffits. If water stains are present, locate and repair the cause of moisture intrusion.
- 4. Check and repair missing mortar in exterior masonry.
- 5. Inspect gutters and downspouts for leaks. Repair if necessary. Check alignment of gutters, downspouts and splash blocks to ensure that water is properly diverted away from the structure and foundation. Repair if necessary.
- 6. Inspect gutters for debris blockage. Remove debris (for example, tree needles and leaves) from downspouts and gutters.
- 7. Check soil around foundation to make sure that it slopes in such a way that water can flow away from the foundation. Fill soil in any areas that have settled around the foundation.



I'm going to hire someone to do some work to prepare my house for winter. Should they have a CCB license if...

...they're cleaning my gutters?

No, you do not need a CCB license to clean gutters. However, they will need a CCB license to make gutter repairs or perform new gutter installation.

...they're weatherizing my house?

Most likely. Some simple weatherizing tasks are so minor that they may not require a CCB license. However, it depends a lot on the scope of the project, cost, and other factors. Minor projects can easily grow in scope, so it's better to hire a licensed professional that can perform any work that comes up during your project.

They will need a license to perform any of the following:

- Pump insulation into the walls
- Repair a broken fireplace damper that won't close
- Replace external doors

...if they're cleaning my chimney?

Yes, you need a CCB license to construct, clean, inspect, repair or sweep a chimney in Oregon.

Remember, hiring a licensed contractor protects you. When you work with a licensed contractor, you have access to the CCB's mediation services. You can also check their license history on our website, which can help you make an informed decision when hiring a professional.

5 Questions to ask before you hire a contractor

Before you hire a contractor to perform a home improvement project, it's important to compare multiple contractors. Speaking with contractors in-person and asking them questions can help you pick the right contractor for your job. You'll probably think of many questions to ask your contractor when they show up at your house. Below are a few questions we recommend homeowners ask contractors before they sign a contract.

1. What's your CCB license number?

Contractors put their CCB number on advertisements, business cards and contracts. However, if you don't see your contractor's CCB number in any of these places, ask for their number.

Hiring a contractor with an active CCB number protects you. Here's how:

Licensed contractors have a track record you can check, and if something goes wrong with your licensed contractor, the CCB has a dispute resolution process to help homeowners and contractors sort out their differences. If you choose to hire an unlicensed contractor, the only recourse if something goes wrong with your home improvement project will be to go to court.

Once you have your contractor's CCB number, check their license number on our website to see if it's active.

- 1. Visit the CCB's website at http://search.ccb.state.or.us/search/
- 2. Type in the CCB number. You'll see the contractor's license number, the name of the business, and the license status. Never hire a contractor with a license status that isn't active. If you don't have the CCB license number you can also search for license contractors using the business or owner's name.
- 3. Select the choose button next to the contractor's CCB number. The website will take you to the CCB license summary for that contractor. There, you'll see if the contractor has any unpaid claims, unpaid civil penalties and history of complaints or disciplinary sanctions.
- 4. Click on learn more about this business, found in the "About this Business" section of the license summary. The business detail shows the type of endorsements or specialty licenses the contractor holds. On this page, you'll be able to see if your contractor has workers compensation coverage. You can also check to see if they have a lead-based paint renovation license, which is required to perform work on houses built before 1978.

2. What's your experience with this kind of work?

It's important to hire a contractor that has relevant experience relating to the type of work that your job requires. This knowledge and experience will help your contractor determine costs and timeline, and will help your contractor manage your project without trouble.

While a less experienced contractor may also be capable of doing the work, you might be taking a risk if you hire someone who has never performed this type of work previously.

How can you tell if the contractor has relevant experience? Experienced contractors should be able to talk knowledgeably about the work they did and may have pictures of previous work to show. They may also have more insightful questions about your project.

3. When can you start work?

Contractors tend to be very busy. You might need the work done soon, but your contractor may not be available for several months. If your home is having an urgent problem, like a roof leak, find out if your contractor can do something in the meantime that can prevent further damage. If you're on a strict timeline, start interviewing contractors as quickly as possible. You may need to interview more contractors until you find a contractor that has availability. Other questions to ask include:

- How long do you anticipate work will take?
- Do you anticipate any conflicts or trouble that could slow down my project? For example, scheduling subcontractors for completion of your project or supply shortages.
- How will you document any necessary change orders?
- Is there anything I can do to keep the process moving or expedite my project?
- What will happen if you're not finished by the anticipated completion date?

4. Do you have references?

Always check a contractor's references before hiring, especially for bigger jobs. Even new contractors should have references from previous employers, businesses or suppliers they've worked with in the past. If possible, contact three references. Ask them questions such as:

- When did this contractor perform work for you?
- What kind of work did the contractor perform?
- Would you hire this contractor again?
- Were you happy with the work the contractor performed?
- Would you recommend this contractor to others?
- How did the contractor handle problems on the job?
- Was the work finished on time? If not, why not?



5. When can I expect a quote?

The first step to working with a contractor is to get a quote. Know when your contractor expects to do this, and when you can follow up if you haven't heard back from your contractor.

Some contractors use their quote as their contract, others may provide a quote and then write up a contract if the quote sounds realistic. Read any documentation your contractor provides thoroughly before signing.

Contracts are required for jobs over \$2,000, however we recommend getting a contract even if the job is for much less. Contracts help establish expectations and give you something to refer back to if you and your contractor have a miscommunication. Ultimately, a good contract will protect both parties and help ensure a

Construction Contractors Board Compliance Section 1st Quarter - 2021-2023 Biennium

July 1, 2021 - September 30, 2021

The Compliance section is charged with evaluating evidence to substantiate violations of ORS 701 and OAR 812. Violation tips and complaints come from the Field Investigation Section (FIS), Dispute Resolution Services (DRS), on-line tips, phone tips as well as from local jurisdictions. The Compliance staff verifies a violation and determines whether an administrative warning or civil penalty is warranted. When warranted Compliance staff has the ability to enter into settlement agreements on behalf of the agency which is usually for a first time offenses. Respondents have a choice of entering into a settlement agreement which is conditional or opting to have an administrative hearing where the Compliance staff would represent the agency as a lay representative.

Construction Contractors Board Dispute Resolution Services 1st Quarter - 2021-2023 Biennium July 1, 2021 - September 30, 2021

Dispute Resolution Services provides a process designed to resolve construction disputes. It is available to persons or businesses alleging that contractors have breached a contract, performed improper work, or failed to pay for work performed or materials supplied. This service involves a mediation service to try to keep disputes out of the court system. If the dispute must be resolved by a court and the consumer who filed the complaint receives a court judgment but the contractor fails to pay the judgment, then the consumer has access to the contractor's bond for payment. Owners of construction companies are prevented from starting new construction businesses until all amounts awarded in the judgments are paid in full. When both parties participate in the mediation process, over 60-70% of those mediations result in a settlement agreement.

Construction Contractors Board Field Investigation Section Quarterly Report for the 2021-2023 Biennium

Knowing that unlicensed and illegal construction activity is bad for consumers and legitimate contractors, the CCB established the Field Investigation Section in 2007, to provide statewide coverage and immediate response to complaints of unlawful activity in the construction industry. The staff includes 10 Investigators, each assigned to their own district in the state, where they are positioned to respond to complaints of illegal construction activity and conduct random checks of local construction sites. Sweeps are executed to find those involved in unlawful construction activity. The Field Investigation Section also participates in joint investigations with other state, county, and city agencies, some of which lead to the filing of injunctions or criminal charges.
