



## Virtual Design Institute April 23, 2019

Between February and April, the Educator Advancement Council (EAC) hosted seven “Design Institutes” around the state to help organizations and educators learn more about creating or participating in educator networks. Recognizing there are those who were unable to attend in person, the EAC is hosting a virtual and modified Design Institute on Tuesday, April 23, 2019, from 9 – 10:45 a.m. to provide:

- An overview of the EAC and pending transition from the Network for Quality Teaching and Learning to statewide access of the Educator Advancement Fund,
- The process being undertaken to identify Regional Educator Networks to help facilitate the work of school districts in their respective regions as they improve systems designed to support educators, and
- Sample processes and tools anticipated to help develop successful networks focused on system change and continuous improvement and driven by teacher voice.
