

2026 Grant Solicitation IMPACTS Grant Program: County Supplemental Funding

Application Due Date: September 30, 2026, at 11:59 PM PDT

Purpose:

The Improving People's Access to Community-based Treatment, Supports and Services (IMPACTS) Program is established in recognition of the shortage of comprehensive community supports and services for individuals with mental health or substance use disorders, leading to their involvement with the criminal justice system, hospitalizations and institutional placements. The purpose of the program is to address this need by awarding grants to counties and Oregon's federally recognized Indian tribes to establish evidence-based and tribal-based programs to provide the needed supports and services.

Eligible Applicants:

Eligible applicants for supplemental funding are Oregon county governments or their designee. In order to be eligible for IMPACTS supplemental funding, a program must have a current IMPACTS 25-27 grant agreement with CJC. Only one application may be submitted per entity.

Recipients of the IMPACTS grant are not required to apply for supplemental funding, but any part of an applicant's supplemental award allocation not requested as part of the supplemental application will be forfeited by that applicant.

If an applicant submitted a multi-jurisdictional application for IMPACTS on behalf of a consortium of government partners, only the main applicant of that consortium may apply for supplemental funding.

Program Goals and Priorities:

Supplemental funding must be used to support existing IMPACTS programming previously approved by the Commission.

Availability and Duration of Funding:

This is a one-time solicitation offering financial support to existing county grant recipients for the grant period beginning July 1, 2025, and ending September 30, 2027. Applicants awarded funds may allocate award funding for costs incurred at any point during the grant period, so long as those funds meet all program rules and requirements found in the [CJC Grant Administration Guide](#) and as outlined in [statute](#) and [rule](#).

A total of \$2,420,500 may be available in grant funds and will be awarded through a pro-rated basis to partially restore the reductions applied during the initial award process. Any amount available over \$1,000,000 is contingent on the Legislature's approval of a pending request to increase CJC's spending limitation.

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Application Timeline:

September 2, 2026	Supplemental application opens
September 30, 2025	Application period closes
November 3, 2026	Criminal Justice Commission makes award decisions

Application Requirements:

1. Applicants must review the [CJC Grant Administration Guide](#) for specific policies and procedures related to allowable uses of grant funds, review processes, and compliance regulations.
2. Pursuant to [Oregon Revised Statute \(ORS\) 430.231](#), applications must be submitted by Local Public Safety Coordinating Council (LPSCC) on behalf of the county. Note: regional consortia applications must be submitted by a single LPSCC or tribal government of the consortium's choosing.
3. Existing county applications must include the following:
 - a. Responses to all supplemental questions; and
 - b. A Supplemental Budget Adjustment Sheet with all applicable sections completed. (See *spreadsheet previously completed in SM Apply*). Applicants must submit spreadsheets in the original formatting and without any revisions of formulas. Spreadsheets with any alterations to formatting or formulas will not be accepted. Requested supplemental funding must align with the purpose and goals of the grant program.
4. Successful applicants will be required to execute an amendment to their existing 2025-27 IMPACTS Grant Agreement.

CJC Comments Regarding Application Questions:

It is strongly recommended that applicants first read through all application questions and closely review the list of required documentation listed in the Supplemental Grant Solicitation.

Existing County Applicant Supplemental Questions:

1. Describe how supplemental funding would support your program. Include any program components previously reduced, paused or eliminated that will be restored. If no components were altered, explain how the funding would increase capacity, expand services, or otherwise strengthen program operations. (Word limit: 150 words)
2. Describe local service gaps that have been identified and explain how supplemental funds will address the gaps identified. Ensure all goals and objectives are specific, measurable, achievable, relevant, and time-bound (SMART) to the remaining grant period. (Word limit: 150 words)
3. Describe your plan to ensure the amount of supplemental funds requested will be used in their entirety by the end of the grant period, September 30, 2027, in steps. (Word limit: 150 words)
