

2026 Supplemental Funding Solicitation: Oregon Justice Reinvestment Program

Application Due Date: October 25, 2026, at 11:59 PM PDT

Purpose:

The Justice Reinvestment Program (JRP) funds initiatives that assess individuals and provide a continuum of community-based sanctions, services, and programs to reduce recidivism and state prison usage, while maintaining public safety and accountability. The JRP is part of Oregon's Justice Reinvestment Initiative, a proactive approach to effectively spend resources in the state's criminal justice system. Under the justice reinvestment model, prison growth is limited, and a portion of the avoided operational prison costs are reinvested in the state's local public safety systems.

Eligible Applicants:

Eligible applicants are Oregon county governments through their Local Public Safety Coordinating Council (LPSCC).

In order to be eligible for JRP supplemental funding, a program *must* have a current JRP 25-27 grant agreement with CJC. Recipients of the 25-27 JRP grant are not required to apply for supplemental funding, but any part of an applicant's supplemental formula allocation not requested as part of the supplemental application will be forfeited by that applicant.

Rural counties may apply for supplemental grants in cooperation with other rural counties.

Program Goals and Priorities:

Supplemental funding must be used to support existing JRP-funded programs previously approved by the Commission.

Availability and Duration of County Funding:

This is a one-time solicitation offering additional financial support to existing county government JRP programs for the grant period beginning July 1, 2025, and ending September 30, 2027.

A total of \$1,098,411 may be made available in supplemental grant funds to existing county grantees and will be awarded through the 2025-2027 formula determined by state law. Any amount available over \$604,000 is contingent on the Legislature's approval of a pending request to increase CJC's spending limitation.

Ten percent of available funds will be set aside and must be distributed to existing community-based nonprofit organizations that provide services to victims of crime.

Final funding allocations will be posted to the CJC JRP website with the supplemental application opening.

Application Requirements:

1. Applicants must review the [CJC Grant Administration Guide](#) for specific policies and procedures related to allowable uses of grant funds, review processes, and compliance regulations.
2. Applicants must first officially opt to apply through an opt-in survey that will be emailed out to all existing grantees via Microsoft Forms.
3. Applicants who opt in will then be able to apply for supplemental funds. The application will include a completed budget projection sheet, which will be emailed out to each opted-in grantee. It must be submitted using the original formatting and formulas provided to the applicant by the CJC, or it will not be accepted.
 - a. The budget projection for the supplemental funds *must not exceed, but may be less than*, an applicant's respective total county supplemental allocation as detailed in the 2026 JRP Supplemental Funding Table.
 - b. Grant requests may only be for adding funds to existing line items, which must also adhere to their approved JRP *Formula and Competitive programming*.
 - c. Victim Services: After receiving notice of the funds awarded, successful applicants will be required to submit a completed budget projection sheet.
 - d. No adjustments to existing budgets will be accepted as part of this supplemental funding process.
4. Successful applicants will be required to execute an amendment to their existing 2025-27 JRP Grant Agreement.
