

2026 Supplemental Funding Solicitation: Organized Retail Theft Grant Program

Application Opt-In Due Date: September 9, 2026, at 5:00 p.m.

Final Application Due Date: September 30, 2026, at 5:00 p.m.

Purpose:

The Organized Retail Theft (ORT) Grant Program was established by the legislature in 2023 Oregon Laws Chapter 582, Section 1, found at ORS 137.686, and modified by HB 3069 (2025). The purpose of the ORT Grant Program is to financially assist local law enforcement agencies and the Oregon Department of Justice with costs associated with addressing and prosecuting *organized retail theft*, as defined in ORS 164.098.

Eligible Applicants:

Eligible applicants are existing ORT grant-funded cities or counties who have indicated an associated need for additional funding for their ORT program. In order to be eligible for ORT supplemental funding, a program *must* have a current ORT 25-27 grant agreement with CJC.

Program Goals and Priorities:

Supplemental funding must be used to enhance efforts to reduce organized retail theft.

Funds awarded must be spent on personnel or contractual service expenses associated with addressing and prosecuting organized retail theft.

Availability and Duration of Funding:

This is a one-time solicitation offering financial support to existing ORT grant recipients for the grant period beginning October 1, 2025, and ending September 30, 2027.

A total of \$517,274 may be available in grant funds and will be awarded through a formula funding process as approved by the Commission in September 2026. Any amount available over \$289,000 is contingent on the Legislature's approval of a pending request to increase CJC's spending limitation.

Application Timeline:

September 2, 2026	Grant solicitation released; Application opt-in opens
September 9, 2026, at 5:00 p.m.	Application opt-in due
September 16, 2026	Final application opens
September 30, 2026, at 5:00 p.m.	Final application due
November 3, 2026	Commission makes final award decisions

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Application Requirements:

1. Applicants must review the [CJC Grant Administration Guide](#) for specific policies and procedures related to allowable uses of grant funds, review processes, and compliance regulations.
2. Applicants must complete both the Application opt-in and Final Application on the due dates provided, along with the corresponding materials listed below.

Application opt-in must include a formal opt-in survey response.

Final Applications must include the following:

- a. A supplemental budget adjustment sheet (spreadsheet available in SMAApply), which must be submitted using the original formatting and formulas included by the CJC or it will not be accepted. Requested supplemental funding must align with the purpose and goals of the grant program; and
 - b. Acknowledgement of supplanting regulations.
3. Successful applicants will be required to execute an amendment to their existing 2025-27 ORT grant agreement.
