Oregon Law Enforcement Agencies:

The Statistical Transparency of Policing (STOP) Project Team has completed several steps towards releasing a request for proposal (RFP) for the STOP technical solution. The solution will collect legally mandated data elements from discretionary police traffic and pedestrian stops. The collection of this data is intended to identify patterns or practices of racial profiling by police in Oregon. The team is currently working closely with the Office of the State Chief Information Officer (OSCIO) and the Department of Justice (DOJ) to post the RFP within the next week.

The engagement and participation of Tier 1 agencies in the business analysis and process design has been invaluable in the development of the Business Case and the RFP. As we continue through the RFP and procurement process, we expect to have a contract signed with a Vendor by the end of February, 2018 to immediately begin work on standing up a solution for Tier 1 agencies by July 1, 2018.

Other project updates include:

- A Technical Lead will be joining the STOP project team this week to help Law Enforcement Agencies understand how their tools, systems and applications can connect to the technical architecture of the STOP solution.
- The data elements required in HB 2355 are being further clarified by the STOP project's Steering Committee and the Department of Justice with input from the Criminal Justice Commission and the STOP project's Stakeholder Engagement Group which consists of several law enforcement and related agencies.
- The Stakeholder Engagement Group meets monthly and will hold its next meeting December 11, 2017, at OSP's General Headquarters.
