Need Statement	To establish expenditure limits allowing state agencies without a 2025-27 Legislatively Adopted Budget to continue operating after June 30, 2025.
Explanation	Without this rule, state agencies without a Legislatively Adopted Budget would cease operating on July 1, 2025. This would result in a loss of services to the public, other state agencies, and the employees of these agencies.
