The Oregon Department of Administrative Services (DAS) has commissioned **BBC Research & Consulting (BBC)** to conduct a disparity study to assess whether any barriers exist for **small businesses, service-disabled veteran-owned businesses, person of color-owned businesses, or woman-owned businesses** that make it more difficult for them to compete for or perform State work.
