Notice of Intent to Award

The State of Oregon, Department of Administrative Services, Procurement Services (DAS PS) and the Evaluation Team have completed evaluation of proposals received in response to Request for Proposals DASPS-2613-16; Management Review of ODOT.

Proposals hold the following ranked order, based on the evaluation criteria and scoring methods prescribed in Section 4 of the RFP:

Ranked Proposers:

1. John L. Craig
2. Public Works

Total Score after Evaluation:

130
121

As a result; John L. Craig is named as the apparent successful proposers in accordance with RFP Section 3.

Pursuant to RFP Section 4.1.3, adversely affected Proposers shall have seven (7) calendar days from the date of any Notice of Intent to Award Contracts within which to file a written protest. Agency shall consider only protests stipulating an issue of fact concerning the following subjects:

1. All higher ranked proposals are non-responsive;
2. Agency failed to conduct the evaluation of proposals in accordance with the criteria or processes described in the RFP;
3. Agency abused its discretion in rejecting the Proposer's Proposal as non-responsive; or
4. Agency's evaluation of Proposals or its subsequent determination of award is otherwise in violation of Oregon Revised Statutes chapters 279A or 279B.

Protests must:

- a. Demonstrate that Proposer would be eligible to be awarded the Contract in the event that its protest is sustained and therefore is adversely affected;
- b. Specify the alleged facts supporting such claim;
- c. Specify the grounds upon which the protest is based, which shall be limited to Oregon Revised Statutes 279B.410;
- d. Specify the alleged facts supporting the specified basis;
- e. Identify the Proposer and reference Agency RFP # DASPS-2360-15R1
- f. Be signed in ink by Proposer's authorized representative;
- g. Be submitted to Agency by the due date for Protests of Award identified in the Notice of Intent to Award a Contract;
- h. Be submitted to Agency at the address specified for the Sole Point of Contact stated in Section 1.3; and
- i. Be delivered via U.S. Mail, courier, or hand delivered.

Please note: Late, electronically transmitted (e.g. faxed, e-mailed) or postage due Protests will not be accepted.

Pursuant to Oregon Administrative Rules, Agency is not permitted to consider award protests submitted after the award protest due date. Award protests shall be resolved in accordance with Oregon Administrative Rules.

Protests must be delivered to the DAS PS Sole Point of Contact identified in RFP Section 1.3 by 5:30 PM on Wednesday – July 6, 2016.

Service of this Notice of Intent to Award Contracts is effective upon email notification of it's posting to the ORPIN System.
