The Oregon Sustainability Board is tasked to help create a culture of sustainability in state agencies. As part of this process, the ISCN reports on statewide sustainability metrics to deepen and broaden our understanding and actions towards that end. For efficient and comprehensive reporting in the ISCN agency plan updates, the Board developed the following template for reporting on statewide metrics. Individual agency metrics will be reported separately in the agency plan updates.

Resource conservation

Progress with existing statewide goal of reducing agency-owned facility energy use (ORS 276.915: 20% agency reduction by 2015, with 2016 and beyond goal in development) and reducing state agency water use (EO 15-09: 15% agency reduction by 2020). A waste reduction goal is in development
