CPERS	Centralized PERS Services Team	The DAS CPERS team is a liaison between PERS and agency HR/payroll partners.

DADA	Disability Application Determination Approval	Disability claim determination letter
DADD	Disability Application Determination Denial	Disability claim determination letter
DIR	Disability Information Request	Disability form CPERS emails to agency
DOD	Date of Death	Date of death in PPDB should be the same date shown on death certificate
EPPT	Employer Paid Pre-Tax	
ER#	Employer Number	PERS employer number. Each agency has their own PERS #.
GS	General Service	
IAP	Individual Account Program	This is the account employee contributions go into
IAP VC	IAP Voluntary Contributions

LOA	Leave of Absence	Leave without pay

PERS Tier 1		Started working in a PERS-qualifying position before January 1, 1996
PERS Tier 2		Started working in a PERS-qualifying position between January 1, 1996, and August 28, 2003
PERS Class Plan Code		Codes entered in Workday that reports employees job class (GS, PF, Judge etc.) to PERS and sets up the Pension amount to pay to PERS
PERS Pension		Amount employers pay to PERS based on employee's PERS class plan code in Workday
PF or P&F	Police and Fire	
PMF	Personnel Medical File	Request of personnel/medical file information for disability benefit
Q	Qualifying	Referring to position status
REMP	Re-Employment	Employee chooses to un- retire or goes over their retiree hour limit
Retirement Date		Retirement date for PERS purposes is always the first day of the month
Retirement Service Credit		This is different than the employees recognized service date in PPDB
RHIA	Retirement Health Insurance Account	
RHIPA	Retiree Health Insurance Premium Account	
SHR	Salary and Hour request	Form used to report hours and wages prior to 2004
SL	Sick Leave	
SRA	Service Retirement Application	
Status Check		A process required at time of hire that provides agencies with PERS membership information.
Student Workers		Employees who are receiving school credit
TBE	Term Before Eligible
