Job Status Display

SCREEN PURPOSE

OSPS uses the P031 Job Status Display to maintain job segments and resolve data interface issues between PPDB and OSPA. The screen is only available to OSPS staff members.

OSPS will only make changes to the current and prior job records.

ALSO KNOWN AS

PREREQUISITES, IF ANY

OSPS makes changes after a request from an agency staff member, either via telephone or e-mail.

SCREEN ACCESS KEY SEQUENCE

To access the P031, you must sign-on with agency ALL.

SSN = social security number (########). Do not enter the hyphens. Enter any leading zeroes. Either the SSN or EID is required.


EID = employee identification number (OR######). Either the SSN or EID is required.

Agency = OSPA agency number (####). Required, because you must sign-on as agency all to access the P031.

CCJ = concurrent job number (#, 1-9). Optional. The records on this screen are concurrent job specific. If you do not enter a number, OSPA will default to 1.

Date = 999999 (current record) or last STOP date for agency number, will default when you perform the inquiry.

L	PERS AGY from the P030 Job Status Data, #####, part of the screen access key sequence.

0	Separation code. Indicates if employee is currently active or has separated from the position.

	 M = approved and/or directed by Budget and Management (BAM), DAS, to address budget issues P = may not be > 1.0 FTE T = short-term transition of employees into pending vacant positions for training X = exempt from ORS 240 0 = not a double fill 		
Y	Separation code. Indicates if employee is currently active or has separated from the position.		
	Possible values include: Y = separated from position 0 = not separated.		

NOTES

Examples of how OSPS uses the P031 include:

- Change the SEP CODE from 0 to Y
- Employee entered time on On-line Daily Time for dates after the employee's separation date. Changing the STOP date will allow the employee to delete the extra time.
- Correct the START and STOP dates for different job segments
- When changes were made to the wrong concurrent job, OSPS can move the changes to the appropriate concurrent job.
- Delete a record in OSPA when a record is deleted in PPDB and the delete does not interface to OSPA
