P032 JOB STATUS DISPLAY

SCREEN PURPOSE

Screens

The P032 Job Status Display provides a quick view of an employee's service history. You may use the STOP dates on this screen to inquire on the P030 Job Status Data. It is concurrent job specific.

ALSO KNOWN AS

PREREQUISITES, IF ANY

The P032 Job Status Display summarizes data entered for the employee in the PPDB and interfaced to OSPA. There will be a separate line for each job segment for each concurrent job.

SCREEN ACCESS KEY SEQUENCE

P032,SSN or Employee ID,agency,CCJ,date (P032 ######## ##### #MMDDYY

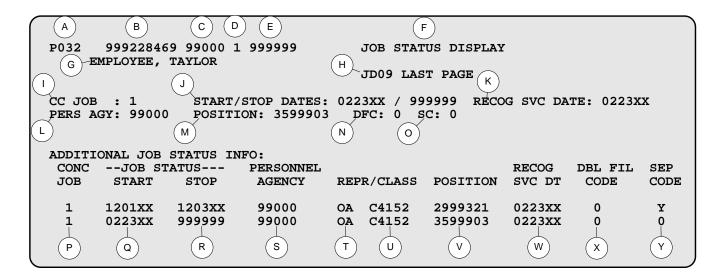
- **SSN** = social security number (#######). Do not enter the hyphens. Enter any leading zeroes. You must enter either the SSN or Employee ID.
- **Employee ID** = employee identification number, OR######. You must enter either the SSN or Employee ID.
- **Agency** = OSPA agency number (#####). Optional. If you have logged on with an agency number (rather than ALL), OSPA will default to that agency number.
- **CCJ** = concurrent job number (#, 1-9). Optional. The records on this screen are concurrent job specific. If you do not enter a number, OSPA will default to 1.
- **Date** = 999999 (current record) or last STOP date for agency number, will default when you perform the inquiry.
