Is the vehicle E-85 compatible?

E-85 Identifiers

A Flex Fuel Vehicle (FFV) operates on E-85 and/or Unleaded fuel. Consult owners manual regarding E-85 compatibility.





Smoking is not permitted while fueling your vehicle or within 25 feet of dispensers. Doing so could result in a serious fire and/or injury.



There are 3 fire extinguishers; 2 on poles, 1 on wall (view from exit side).



BEFORE fueling, please note the location of the following emergency equipment:

EMERGENCY SHUT-OFFS

In the event of an emergency that requires the pump to be stopped, there are 2 Emergency Shut-Off switches. Turning off the switch will cut the power to all the pumps and card readers at the fuel island.

Center island next to E-85 pump.



BEFORE fueling, please note the location of the following emergency equipment:

EMERGENCY PHONE NUMBERS

The site operator's telephone number is posted at the site. If you need assistance or need to report a spill or problem, call this number. In the event of an emergency call **911**.

EMERGENCY TELEPHONE - 911 CALLS ONLY

No coins needed – (front office entrance)



In case of fuel spill or release...

In the event of a fuel spill during hours, turn off emergency shut-off switch, then notify Motor Pool office staff.

In the event of a fuel spill after hours, turn off emergency shut-off switch, then call 911.



Fuel Island...

Approaching the fuel island, signs denote the location of the different fuel types. You can fuel from either side.



Fuel Island...

The fuel dispenser has 2 hoses.



Dispenser operation...



1) Remove fuel nozzle from dispenser.



2) Flip on/off lever up to "ON" position.

3) Remove vehicle fuel cap and insert nozzle in fuel neck.



Swiping Voyager card...


4) Swipe the Voyager card



Proper card direction: magnetic
strip down and to the right.

Insert the card , then remove
quickly.

After swiping Voyager card...




5) ODOMETER:

Prompt to enter vehicle odometer reading.

Using keypad, enter odometer reading (no tenths) then “Enter” button.

At this point some customers will be prompted for an **ID #**.

This is available from the vehicle’s operating agency.




6) HOSE:

Prompt to enter fuel hose #.

Using keypad, enter hose # then “Enter” button.

7) OK, START PUMPING-

Transaction complete. The chosen fuel dispenser is ready pump fuel.



Begin fueling...

8) The dispenser meter will automatically “zero.”



9) While squeezing handle to open, use index finger to push the lock lever down.

10) When vehicle tank is full, the handle will “click” off automatically. **DO NOT TOP OFF** (DEQ Regulation).

Finish fueling...

9) Return lever back to the **“OFF”** position. Replace nozzle in holder.



10) Tighten gas cap until it **“clicks.”**
