3 **Section 1.** The Agency shall provide to its employees all safety apparel and safety

devices necessary to meet the requirements of the Oregon Safe Employment Act. The

Agency shall provide to its employees all safety apparel and safety devices necessary to

meet the requirements of the Agency. The Agency will also provide required uniforms

and/or protective clothing and/or protective devices, including hardhats, for the type of

8 industry being visited or inspected.

9 **Section 2.** Uniforms and protective clothing shall remain the property of the Agency and

shall be returned to the Agency upon termination of employment. Damage to uniforms

and protective clothing judged by the Agency to need replacement shall be replaced by

the Agency. Uniforms, protective clothing, or protective devices lost or damaged as a

result of gross negligence of the employee shall be replaced by the employee. Uniforms,

protective clothing, or protective devices may not be used for personal reasons.

15 **Section 3.** Permanent, limited duration, and seasonal employees (continuously

employed for nine (9) months or more), may make a request of their supervisor for

reimbursement of up to enetwo hundred dollars (\$100200.00) per biennium for personal

clothing damages which occur in the course of their assigned duties in circumstances

where they are required to work in the field and protective clothing is not available. The

supervisor may require specific information about how the damage occurred.
