ARTICLE 33.3A--MEAL ALLOWANCE (ODOT Except DMV)

3 Section 1. Eligible Classifications: Machinist (C4018); Automotive Technicians

4 (C4418), (C4419); Electricians (C4007), (C4008), (C4009); Heavy Equipment

5 Technicians (C4436), (C4437), (C4438) Entry, 1, & 2; Transportation Maintenance

6 Specialists 1 & 2 (C4151), (C4152); Transportation Maintenance Coordinator (C4162); 1

7 & 2 and Transportation Operations Specialist (C4163) or their successor classifications;

8 Transportation Telecommunications Specialists (C4166), (C4167) and Incident

9 Response Operations Specialist (C4165).

Section 2. Allowance Amount. An employee who is required to work two (2) hours

or more past their scheduled eight (8) or ten (10) hour shift, without the use of

personal leave, in one (1) of the above classifications, who is required to work ten (10)

consecutive hours or more for those on a five/eight (5/8) or twelve (12) consecutive hours

or more for those on a four/ten (4/10) schedule and when, because of such extra work, is

not permitted by the supervisor to return to their residence for a meal, shall receive a meal

allowance of twelve fifteen dollars (\$1215.00). This provision shall not apply to any

employee on an assignment where any form of travel expense is being allowed.

Section 3. Allowance Limitation. Any employee working sixteen (16) to twenty-four

(24) consecutive hours shall receive an additional five eight dollars (\$58.00) for a total of

seventeen twenty-three dollars (\$1723.00) for the twenty-four (24) hour period.
