2	Article 101.5 – Safety and Health
3	(All Agencies)

5	This Letter of Agreement is entered into between the State of Oregon, by the Department of
6	Administrative Services (DAS), Labor Relations Unit and the Service Employees International
7	Union (SEIU) Local 503.
8	
9	The Employer and Union hold a shared interest in maintaining safe workplaces for all
10	employees. When employees communicate have concerns about safety in the public access
11	areas of their building, those concerns should be discussed with their supervisor or
12	manager, or can may be raised with the Agency's Labor Management Committee (LMC) or
13	Safety Committee for review. The safety concern will may be placed on the LMC or Safety
14	Committee agenda and will remain there until the concern has been resolved. The LMC or
15	Safety Committee may, at any time during these discussions, file a project authorization
16	<u>request <mark>with</mark> a DAS <del>to have a</del> safety assessment <mark>and quote performed for the public access</mark></u>
17	areas of the building, if appropriate.
18	
19	either the sublocal executive team or the union members of the agency Labor Management
20	Committee (LMC) may, at any time, file a project authorization request with DAS to have
21	a safety assessment and quote performed for the public access areas of a building. When
22	the requesting party has received the results of the assessment and quote, the requesting
23	party and the Agency will schedule a meeting to discuss them.
24	
25	When a building is scheduled for a restack, the LMC will be notified of the restack and its
26	timeline project schedule. The LMC will participate in making sure that the tenant
27	interviews include represented employees from each area of the building being reviewed.
28	The final plans for regarding the public access areas of the building will be reviewed shared
29	with the LMC.
30	
31	e The entire plan will be reviewed with all sublocal executive teams that represent
32	employees in the building for questions and input prior to finalizing the plans.
33	The Employee and Union held a should interest in maintaining sofe yearly lease for all
34	The Employer and Union hold a shared interest in maintaining safe workplaces for all
35	employees. The Employer shall commission a safety assessment for all offices that are open to
36	the public, performed by a qualified, independent safety expert by December 31, 2025.
37	The Agency and the Union will areate Safety Agencyment Committees no later than December
38	The Agency and the Union will create Safety Assessment Committees no later than December 31, 2025. The Committees shall be comprised of three (3) employee members appointed by the

42	the building and each agency shall have two (2) employee members appointed by the union and
43	two (2) members of management from each Agency.

45	The Safety Assessment Committee will convene to discuss the safety assessment and to
46	determine which recommendations will be implemented and how the implementation will occur.
47	The Safety Assessment Committee will complete its work on the safety assessment by December
48	<del>31, 2026.</del>
49	
50	Running meeting minutes from the Safety Assessment Committee will be published on the
51	Agency's internal website.
52	
53	Committee meetings convened in accordance with the LOA will be on paid status and shall be
54	reimbursed for authorized travel expenses as per State Travel Policy. Agencies will not incur any
55	overtime as a result of committee meetings or travel.
56	
57	Any remodel, move, and/or restack will restart the timelines within this LOA and will convene a
58	new Safety Assessment Committee.
59	
60	Nothing in this Letter of Agreement is intended as a waiver of the Union's right to bargain over
61	the impact of the installation and usage of video surveillance should that be a decision of the
62	Safety Assessment Committee.
