

Workday Access

Quick Reference Guide

Multifactor Authentication (MFA)

If you have a work assigned Microsoft account, you are required to use MFA. MFA is an electronic authentication method in which a user is granted access to a website or application only after successfully presenting evidence to an authentication mechanism. MFA adds a layer of protection to the sign-in process. MFA provides single sign on opportunities, meaning once you sign into My Microsoft Accounts, other applications may recognize you without requiring you to login again with a user id and password.

Access to Workday with a Microsoft Account (state-issued device)

You will benefit from a single sign on experience with Workday using this link: https://wd5.myworkday.com/oregon/login-saml2.flex. Simply copy and paste the link to your browser and it will recognize you without requiring your username, password, or challenge questions. Workday will still have a session timeout, so you will need to click back into Workday if your session times out. This job aid provides instructions on how to set up browser favorites/bookmarks or a shortcut.

Access to Workday without a Microsoft Account (personal device)

If a user does not have a work issued Microsoft account (i.e.: Board members who do not have state-issued Microsoft accounts), their experience will vary by user type:

- External Job Applicants (not currently state employee) No change in experience.
- External Learners (citizens accessing publicly available training and information) No change in experience.
- State users that do not have M365 accounts (pre-employment individuals, post-employment individuals, contractors, board/commission members and other volunteers without state-issued M365 account) These users will no longer be required to respond to challenge questions. They will be required to MFA with an authenticator app and one-time passcode. To set up the authenticator application, follow this job aid. All users who access the URL (Workday Native) will be prompted to setup MFA and will be able to login 3 times before being forced to setup MFA.

Note: Five unsuccessful login attempts will result in a 20-minute system lockout.
