## Installing & Using Chrome Authenticator for Workday Multifactor Authentication (MFA)

**Update:** After continued discussions with DAS - Enterprise Information Services - Cyber Security Services, we are **no longer providing instructions** on the use of the Google Chrome Authenticator. For users who do not have a state issued M365 account or need urgent access to Workday for personal use (non-state business), see the <a href="Workday MFA">Workday MFA</a> <a href="Setup">Setup</a> job aid for detailed instructions on how to set-up MFA on a personal device, such as a smart phone.

As an alternative, a personal or state provided YubiKey can be used as your Workday MFA authentication method. If you do not already have a YubiKey, it is recommended that you reach out to your contact at the State Agency you are serving with (as an employee, volunteer or contractor) to determine if one may be provided.

*Note:* If you already had MFA setup on a Chrome Authenticator Extension, you will need to contact your Security Partner(s) to reset your MFA.
