

Learning Management System Replacement

Workday Learning is coming in June 2021!

In June 2021, the state of Oregon will launch Workday Learning as its new learning management system (LMS). Although this transition will replace iLearnOregon, as an Extended Enterprise Learner, you will still have access to state sponsored training. This resource highlights some key considerations to help make your transition to Workday Learning as smooth as possible.

Extended Enterprise Learner

The change to Workday Learning will require a shift in familiar LMS terminology. For example, iLearnOregon uses the term *Agency Partner* to identify any person who collaborates with a state agency, board, and/or commission. When we launch Workday Learning, your designation will change to an *Extended Enterprise Learner*.

June 2021	Go-Live

Workday Learning Training



Training on how to use Workday Learning is anticipated to start in May 2021 and will continue through go-live in June 2021. Training will utilize a variety of platforms such as live virtual learning events, webinars, eLearning, videos, and other learning resources.

Training will address a variety of topics such as, searching for training in the learning catalog, enrolling into a course, canceling enrollment, and accessing learning transcript. You will also receive training on the process to create your Workday Learning profile.

Workday Learning Account Creation

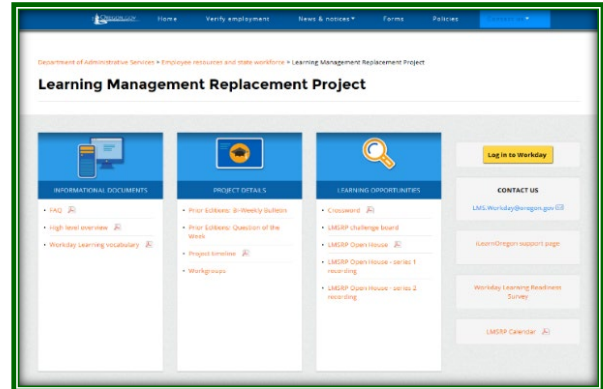
As an Extended Enterprise Learner, your iLearnOregon profile will not transfer into Workday Learning. Once the system is live and you need to complete state sponsored training, you will create your Workday Learning account.
