WHAT IS OREGONBUYS?

OregonBuys is a procure-to-pay eProcurement solution that automates the procurement processes using web-based applications.

It is a technology-enabled solution that allows the state to procure goods and services at the best value. OregonBuys
One unified system –
modernizing state
procurement



OREGONBUYS PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- 1. All state agencies adopt OregonBuys as the state's eProcurement system.
- 2. Standardize and automate procure-to-pay process and provide more transparency and reporting capabilities on statewide spend.
- 3. Enable development of strategic sourcing plans which will allow the state to identify strategic sourcing opportunities to optimize spend.
- 4. Increased competition for state contracts resulting in better contract terms.
- 5. Decommission ORPIN and other procurement-related shadow systems across agencies.



ALIGNMENT WITH STRATEGIC PRIORITIES

One enterprise system tracks & manages agency purchases

OPTIMIZE STATE RESOURCES

Standardizes procurement processes across all agencies

Automates manual processes so staff can focus on strategic work

Enterprise-wide data collection helps agencies identify trends and make informed decisions



ONE PROJECT – TWO PHASES



Now - July 2021

ORPIN Replacement

- OregonBuys replaces ORPIN.
- All agencies transition at the same time.
- ORPIN switches to "read only" mode.



2021 - 2023

Procure-to-Pay Functionality

- Additional procure-to-pay functionality rolls out to agencies in 3 "waves" that last eight months each.
- Functionality includes: requisitions, issuing purchase orders, invoicing and receiving.
- Agencies will self enroll in the wave that best fits their needs.



Replaces ORPIN's core functionality

- Post Solicitations
- Receive, Evaluate and Award Bids

Introduces "Marketplace"

Browse state contracts online

Allows vendors to self-manage their own OregonBuys account

- Search, receive and review Solicitations
- Respond to Solicitations electronically

PHASE 1 ORPIN REPLACEMENT



WHAT'S AVAILABLE IN PHASE 1

Requisitions For agencies sending requests to DAS **Master Blanket Bids Purchase Orders** Solicitations (posting, receiving quotes back from (MBPO) vendors, posting awards) An OregonBuys term for price agreements, or contracts that are ongoing, cross biennial or Marketplace that have renewal potential Online contract browsing



WHAT'S INCLUDED:

- Intermediate procurements by agencies (where delegated authority is present) including posting of results/agreements
- Posting of agreements, emergency procurements, etc.
- Posting of Sole Source procurements by agencies
- Requests to DAS PS including Sole Source, delegations, etc.
- Requests for DAS PS for on-behalf of procurement

PHASE 1 ORPIN REPLACEMENT



WHAT'S INCLUDED (continued):

- Formal procurements by DAS PS or agencies
- Support of Buy Decision through Marketplace searching
- Where authority exists, managing Bid Solicitations:
 - Creating and posting Bid Solicitation documents
 - Notifying registered vendors of opportunities
 - Receiving electronic responses
 - Awarding
 - Converting to Master Blanket Purchase
 Order (MBPO)

WHAT WILL CHANGE IN PHASE 1?

TERMINOLOGY

Some names and titles in OregonBuys differ from Oregon's terminology

ROLES

OregonBuys has its own unique user roles and permissions

ELECTRONIC RESPONSES

Receiving, responding and awarding are all done electronically

NEW MARKETPLACE

Marketplace becomes the new place to search for Statewide Price Agreements
