### What is OregonBuys?

OregonBuys is web-based tool that automates procure-to-pay processes — it will be the new statewide eProcurement solution.

#### Why do we need it?

To automate processes, eliminate duplicative and manual steps, and capture information so we can better understand what Oregon state government buys.

#### What is the time line?

First phase is to replace ORPIN (spring 2020), followed by deploying full procure-to-pay functionality to all executive branch agencies in a series of three waves (by summer 2021).

#### Who is affected?

All state agencies — staff in procurement, accounts payable, those who submit purchase requisitions or process purchase orders, managers who approve purchases, vendors who do business with the state, local governments, and potentially others.

## 6 intended project outcomes:

- 1. State agencies adopt OregonBuys as their eProcurement system.
- 2. State spend data is captured and reported on through OregonBuys.
- **3.** Strategic sourcing plans are in place for how the state will identify strategic sourcing opportunities to optimize state spend.
- 4. Prompt payment of invoices results in increased discounts.
- **5.** Increased competition for state contracts results in better contract terms and potential cost savings.
- **6.** ORPIN is decommissioned and a plan is established to replace and decommission other agency procurement systems.
