To implement Federal Flood Plain Management practices for properties owned and managed by the Department.

**EXCLUSIONS AND SPECIAL SITUATIONS**

- Statewide inventory of flood, mud slide and earthquake prone areas is maintained by Department of Geology and Mineral Industries (DOGAMI).

**POLICY AND PROCEDURE**

- The Division will maintain an inventory of properties owned or managed by the Department, which are located in federally designated flood-prone and mud slide-prone areas.
- The Division reviews major construction and capital improvement projects under its management to ensure that construction complies with National Flood Insurance regulations of the Federal Emergency Management Agency, (Title 44 CFR, Chapter 1, Federal Emergency Management Agency). Federal regulations may be complied with by meeting all local zoning ordinance and building code requirements for flood plain construction projects
- Division reviews of Major Construction and Capital Improvement projects under its management to ensure compliance with local zoning ordinances and building codes for construction in flood plain areas will constitute compliance with federal regulations.
