

30% WEIGHTED PRICE EVALUATION PILOT

Frequently Asked Questions

What procurements and solicitations are subject to the 30% weighted price evaluation pilot requirements?

The pilot applies to Request for Proposals (RFP) issued under ORS 279B.060, and OAR 125-247-0260 or OAR 137-047-0260 – 0261.

What's the pilot time frame?

The pilot applies to RFPs advertised on or after January 1, 2019, and before January 2, 2020.

At what step in the evaluation process is 30% weighting applied?

30% weighting criteria must be applied in the final evaluative step. Per ORS 279B.060 Section 3(9)(a), the final evaluative step is the step a contracting agency makes before deciding to issue a notice of intent to award a public contract.

Is an RFP subject to pilot requirements when:

- **Advertised on or after January 1, 2019, but won't be evaluated or awarded until after January 2, 2020?** Yes.
- **Originally advertised prior to January 1, 2019, but wasn't awarded, then re-advertised prior to January 2, 2020?** Yes.
- **Advertised before January 1, 2019, but closed and evaluated after January 1, 2019?** No.

Is there a pilot waiver option?

Yes, per ORS 279B.060 Section 3(9)(b). Visit <https://www.oregon.gov/das/procurement/pages/SB1565.aspx> for waiver instructions and requirements.

Does the pilot apply to Special Procurements?

To be determined under approved Special Procurement process.

Does the pilot apply to NASPO ValuePoint cooperative procurements or other cooperatives?

Yes, if Oregon is the lead state issuing an RFP under ORS 279B.060 and OAR 125-247-0260 or OAR 137-047-0260 – 0261.

What needs to be reported to DAS?

- State contracting agencies must report all RFP price and score information on RFPs issued under ORS 279B.060 during the pilot time period of January 1, 2019 — January 2, 2020. For reporting instructions, visit <https://www.oregon.gov/das/procurement/pages/SB1565.aspx>.
