

30% WEIGHTED PRICE EVALUATION PILOT

Pilot Summary

A pilot program to weight contract price was written into law with the passage of SB 1565 in 2018. State contracting agencies advertising a procurement on or after January 1, 2019, and before January 2, 2020, must weight contract price at not less than 30% in the final evaluation.

The pilot applies to all state contracting agencies, even those not under DAS procurement authority. It affects Request for Proposals (RFP) that meet the following criteria:

- Issued under ORS 279B.060, and
- Issued under OAR 125-247-0260 or OAR 137-047-0260 — 0261

Instructions on how to apply the 30% weighted price evaluation will be added to the statewide RFP template posted on ORPIN.

If it's in the best interest of the state contracting agency, the agency director or other delegated authority may waive the pilot requirement. Visit the DAS website for waiver instructions and additional pilot reporting requirements:
