

**DocuSign Signature and DocuSign CLM Software as a Service (SaaS)
Master Services Agreement (MSA)**

To Authorized Purchasers or whom it may concern,

As with all Master Service Agreements (MSAs) under the Cloud Price Agreements, the Authorized Purchaser will need to satisfy itself that the terms are acceptable and consistent with their intended use of the DocuSign products they purchase. In addition, while we have negotiated each of the Security Attachments with Enterprise Information Services (EIS), Cyber Security Services (CSS) input, that is not an assurance that DocuSign's promises related to its information security and privacy practices are appropriate for any possible use of the DocuSign Signature or CLM products subject to the DocuSign MSA. An agency that wishes to use DocuSign products must satisfy itself, in consultation with EIS and CSS, and DOJ where appropriate, that the products are suitable for the agency's intended use.

Finally, DAS PS and DOJ want to remind you that contracts entered into under the NASPO Cloud Participating Addenda are not generally exempt from the requirement that they be reviewed and approved for legal sufficiency. Any contract, whether entered into under the NASPO Cloud Participating Addenda or otherwise, must be reviewed and approved for legal sufficiency by the DOJ if they call for payments in excess of \$150,000.
