Oregon Certification Program – 3 Components



Education

- OPBC: initial 75 hours, to renew 25 hours
- OPIC: initial 125 hours, to renew 50 hours
- OPAC: initial 175 hours, to renew 50 hours
- Initial certification is the ONLY time OPPT vs OTHER hours matters
- Courses must be within the most recent 5 years

Experience

- Defined as public procurement experience
- OPBC 1 year
- OPIC 3 years
- OPAC 5 years
- Experience does NOT need to be continuous but must be within the past 10 years

Exam

- Must pass with 80% or better for each tier
- 3 Exam offerings per year
- Study session hosted by Trainers prior to each offering
