Oregon is getting a new web-based eProcurement processing system called OregonBuys. This powerful tool will replace the Oregon Procurement Information Network (ORPIN) and will be the statewide eProcurement solution for all state agencies.

FEATURES

OregonBuys features end-to-end automated processes from request through payment, including:

- Workflows and approvals
- Solicitations
- Bid submission
- Purchase orders
- Invoicing and reporting

It will also interface with R*STARS, the state's accounting system, and the Certification Office for Diversity and Inclusion (COBID) Certification system. The best part? No more manual steps and a modern online marketplace shopping experience.



TIMELINE & APPROACH

OregonBuys started as the collaborative effort of ten agencies and is now approved for enterprise adoption. The Department of Administrative Services (DAS) is leading the project and agencies will contribute to the efforts by participating on project teams and implementation workgroups.

Initial planning is now underway and current plans are to sunset ORPIN in early 2020. ORPIN's historical information will remain available after this transition. We'll release more information about the project timeline as soon as it is available.



FUNDING

OregonBuys is fully funded by Vendor Collected Administrative Fees (VCAF) paid on existing Statewide Price Agreements. Agencies don't need to submit funding requests unless they require more staff to assist with implementation.
