

SPLUNK STATEWIDE LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR CLOUD  
READ ME

This Splunk Rider dated 8/20/24 has been reviewed and approved by DOJ for use by state agencies.

In many or most instances the attached EULA will be sufficient, however you will need to follow the directions below to verify:

1. As the EULA is just a part of the licensing that is used by Splunk, the purchaser must review the product specific documents/licenses to verify there are no clauses that are unacceptable.
2. Things to consider include: data ownership, use of agency data, etc..
3. In any event, you must address Section 6.3 in the Rider:

Section 6.3 No Overseas Storage: Agency must select a cloud region in the United States or its territories for provisioning the Hosted Service.

4. You will need to consider any additional licensing or other terms for the specific product, and if there are additional licenses or other terms, for any purchase over \$150,000.00, you will need to send them to DOJ for Legal Sufficiency Review and Approval.
