WHAT IS COVERED / ORDERING INSTRUCTIONS

Agreement 5776 essentially covers two categories of services:

- Access to the COOP Solution
- Additional related services such as training listed on the Menu of Services, Exhibit A to the contract.

There is an Enterprise License in place that provides access to the COOP solution for all entities listed on Table A of the Menu of Services. The Table is attached to this Buyers Guide and can also be found in ORPIN under attachments.

If you are named on the list of Participating Programs on Table A, you have been paid for. You can obtain access to the COOP solution and participate in OEM scheduled training sessions and plan reviews provided by BOLDplanning Inc authorized representatives.

1. Purchasing Access to the COOP Solution

(If you are not on the Table A list of Participating Programs)

Authorized Purchasers wishing to access the COOP Solution must follow the following process:

- A. Draft a COOP Solution Work Order Contract with BOLDplanning (Exhibit C-1 in ORPIN). For information about obtaining ORPIN user access: <http://www.oregon.gov/das/Procurement/Pages/ORPINuser.aspx>
- B. Contact DAS Contract Administrator and send the draft Work Order Contract in order to obtain a WOC number.

- C. The WOC must be signed by the Authorized Purchaser and by BOLDplanning.

- D. Send a copy of the fully executed WOC to BOLDPlanning, DAS Contract Administrator for administrative purposes and entering into ORPIN.

2. Purchasing Additional COOP Services

Authorized Purchasers wishing to purchase additional related services must follow the following process:

- A. Ensure Authorized Purchaser has a valid license to use the COOP Solution (either through OEM as a Participating Program listed on Table A, or through its own WOC).
- B. Draft a Services WOC with BOLDPlanning (Exhibit C-2 in ORPIN).

ENTERING A WOC INTO ORPIN

1. Log into ORPIN
2. In the menu on the left, select “Statewide Contract Search”
3. Select “By Number”
4. Enter 5776
5. Click the WOC generating arrow at the bottom right of the contract information (this will

generate the WOC number).

6. Upload the fully executed WOC, complete and issue the WOC in ORPIN.
