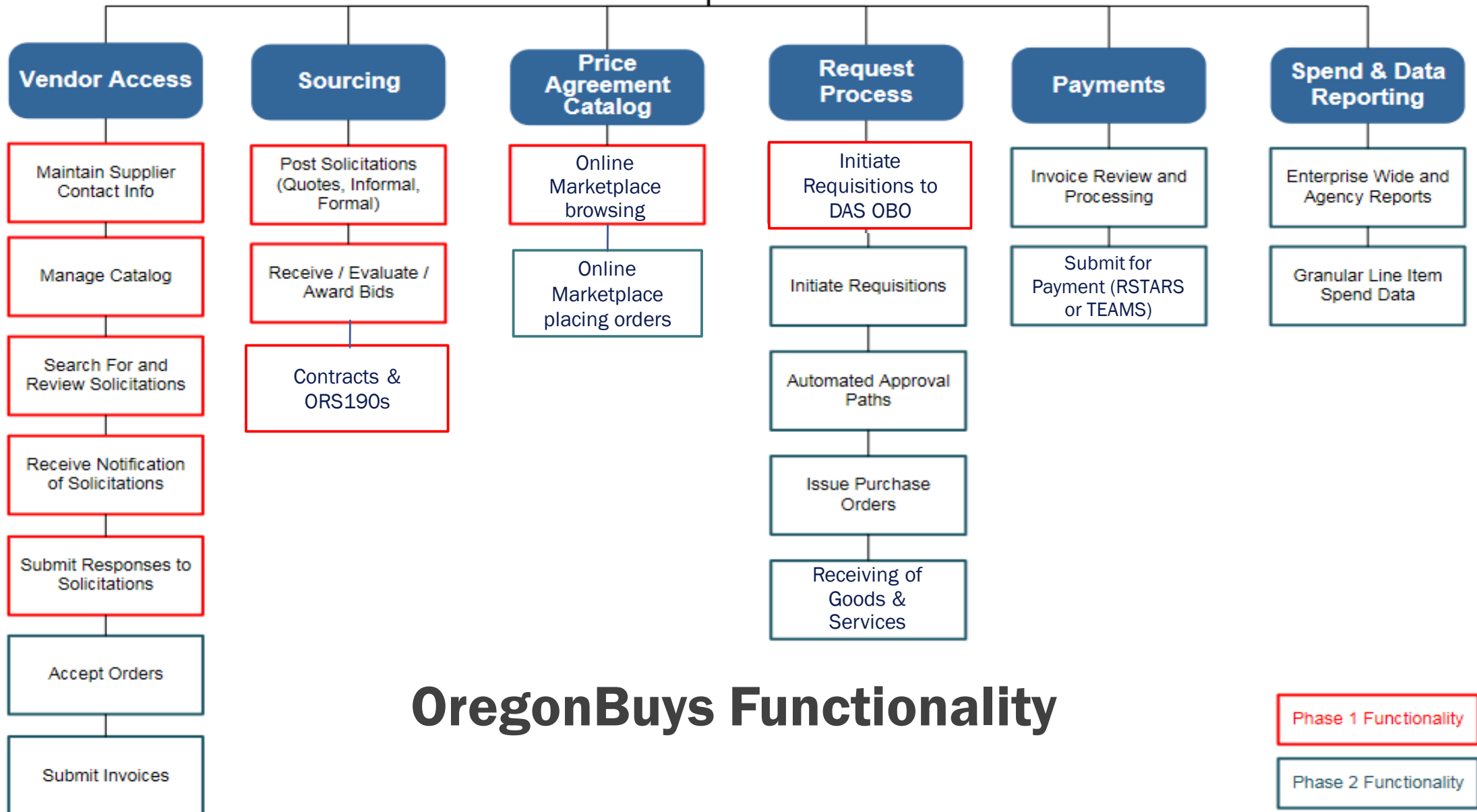

CURRENT PROJECT STATUS

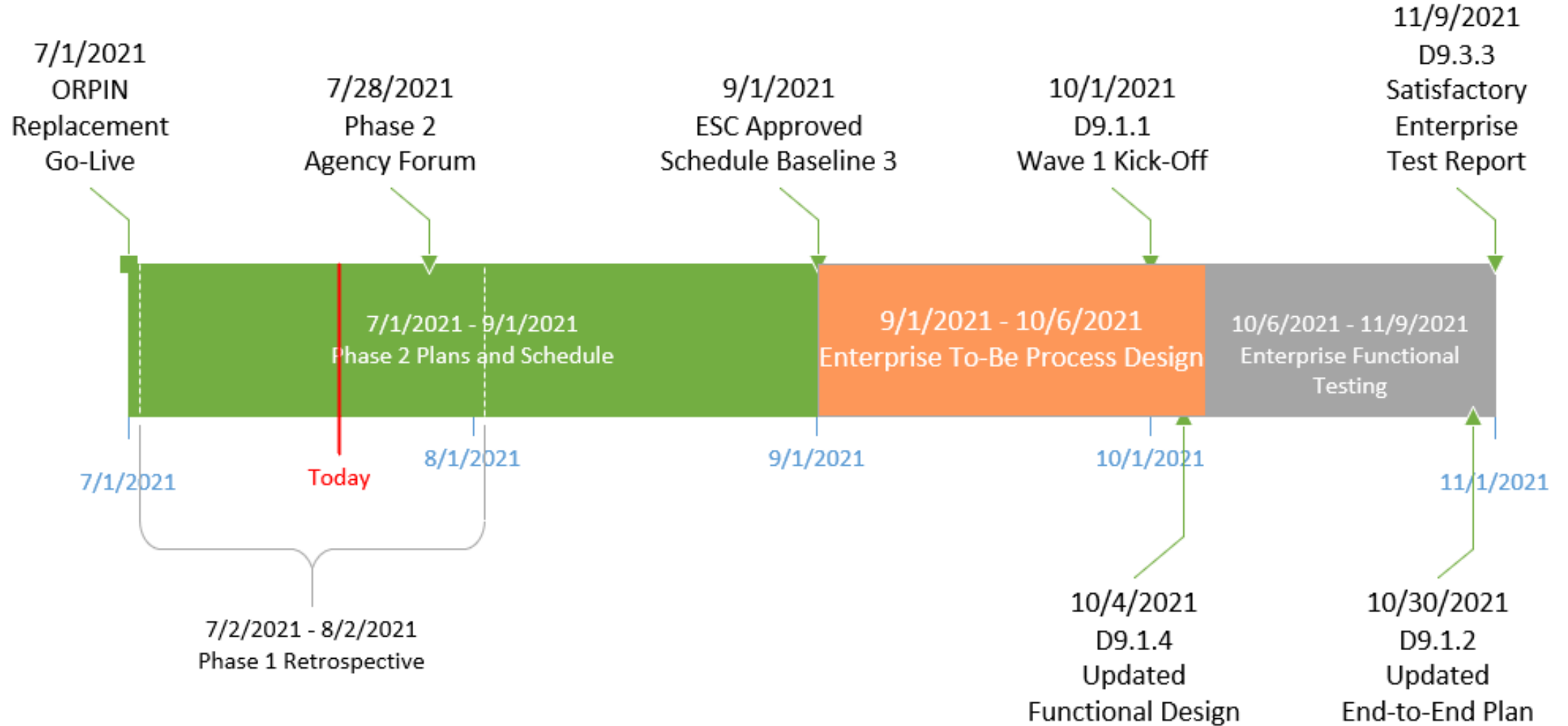
- ORPIN successfully replaced, work to build up OregonBuys Marketplace continues daily
- ORPIN remains available in archive mode
- 1,435 Contracts in sent status and 14,406 in progress
- Agency forum held this morning – gave agencies Phase 2 overview
- Preparing for Phase 2 scope:
 - Capturing all procurement spend through the system
 - Shopping cart purchases using Marketplace
 - Creating Work Order Contracts (WOCs) associated with Price Agreements
 - Creating Requisitions to purchase from existing Agreements
 - Generating Purchase Orders to vendors on Price Agreements to order goods and services
 - Creating Receipts to identify delivery of goods and services
 - Processing invoices for received goods and services (received through OregonBuys or externally)
 - Business Intelligence reporting

ORS190 ENTITIES AND SUPPLIER ACCOUNTS

What should we do if an ORS190 entity isn't registered as a supplier in OregonBuys?

- Agencies and local government entities must have a supplier account to participate in an ORS190
- The agency should contact the entity directly and ask them to create a supplier account:
 - Have them navigate to <https://oregonbuys.gov> and click on the blue “register” button in the top right corner to get started
 - NOTE: DAS isn't doing ORS190 outreach; PHI's support desk is unable to contact entities who need a supplier account for an ORS190

Helpful Tip:

It's easy to find out if an entity has a supplier account! Log in to OregonBuys and put the entity's name in the Advanced Search at the top of the homepage.
