Purpose: Oregon DAS-EGS Risk Management requires employees who need to drive state vehicles on official state business to view “[OAR 125-155 Vehicle Use and Access Orientation](#)” (webinar) prior to operating a state vehicle. The rules allow agencies to set additional requirements for employees who operate state vehicles.
