## **RISK MANAGEMENT**

<u>Purpose:</u> A state driver operating a state vehicle on official state business under a DMV Hardship Permit can create an increased liability to the state/agency. This diagram outlines the process to assess the DMV Hardship Permit Application (735-6044) of a state driver. It utilizes the Adverse Driver Risk Assessment (<u>VUAT-2E</u>), Adverse Driver Loss Control Plan (<u>VUAT-2C</u>), Interactive Process for Loss of Driving Privileges (<u>VUAT-2E</u>), Checklist for Loss of Driving Privileges (<u>VUAT-2E</u>), Vehicle Use and Access Orientation webinar, and Employee Restricted Driving Responsibilities Agreement (<u>VUAT-2G</u>). (For IID Exception Process, see <u>VUAT-2D</u>.)

<u>Caveat:</u> This process applies to employees previously authorized to drive state vehicles on official state business who now have a restricted license. New state drivers or existing drivers whose driving records are under periodic review should be assessed under Driver Authorization Process (<u>VUAT-1A</u> or <u>VUAT-1E</u>).
