







Recent trends in circuit court cases filed









Methodology





- New Cases: Long-term overall case growth is determined by the respective population growth for that case type.
- Near-term growth is based on a transition from the most recent actual fiscal year growth to the outer-year growth pattern.
- Fiscal year in progress is also informed by YTD growth.
- Example: Adult Misdemeanor






- Eligible population is determined by the historical patterns in eligibility percentage, both levels and trends.
- Example: Adult Misdemeanor.

Misdemeanor Eligibility


Percent of all new adult misdemeanor cases eligible for public defense





- Ongoing Cases: Depending on the historical patterns, recent levels and trends inform the forecast of each type of case (e.g., Pretrial, Reinstatement, etc.).

Risks to the Forecast



Potential Risks



- Ancillary detection, arrest and charging activity owing to HB 4002
- Continuing disconnect between measures of criminality and circuit court processing.
- Eventuality of HB 4002 relative to impact estimates.
- General deviations in the demographic forecast in the long run.

Major Changes (Adult):



Misdemeanors:

- FY 2024 finished much stronger than was previously tracking.
- FY 2025 and FY 2026 have been revised upward according to the methodology previously described.

Felony & Probation Violations:

- FY 2024 finished significantly more negative than was tracking in March.
- The "glide path" to long-term growth has been revised down.

All other case types reflect minor adjustments owing to addition of four months of actual data.
