



DCBS gets reports about medical payments made by insurers, self-insured employers, and the Workers' Benefit Fund for non-complying employer claims. In 2017, there were 1.42 million services reported to the agency.

This chart shows 2017 data for the category of medical payments called "physician services." This includes things like office visits, surgery, injections, and other services delivered by a medical provider. The chart shows the share of total physician services by provider type. Examples of "other types" include providers like physical and occupational therapists, acupuncturists, behavioral health providers, optometrists, or pathologists.

It is not possible to determine whether the provider was acting in the role of attending physician at the time the service was provided.
