Subject: Proposed amendments HB 2087 – civil penalty cap

Based on discussions with committee members, the division plans to propose an amendment to HB 2087. The amendment would lower the proposed per violation civil penalty on insurers, self-insured employers, and service companies from \$9,000 to \$4,000. The overall cap amount would be retained.

The amendment would be on page 1, lines 21-24:

(b) The director may not assess under this subsection a civil penalty against a self-insured employer, insurer or service company that exceeds [~~\$9,000~~ \$4,000 for each violation or \$180,000 in the aggregate for violations during a calendar year. Each violation, or each day during which a violation continues, constitutes a separate violation.
