 SUBJECT: COVID-19 reported claim information as of **June 24, 2020**

The Workers' Compensation Division (WCD) receives some reports of workers' compensation claims, except 1) accepted nondisabling claims where only medical services were provided and 2) City of Portland Fire and Police Disability and Retirement claims which are covered by a separate system. Insurers must report a claim to the division within 14 days of acceptance or denial of the claim.

The data is for claims where COVID-19 is specifically listed in claim documents reported *as of June 24, 2020*.

The division tracks reported claims by whether they are filed for COVID-19 exposure or the disease itself. The bulk of claims reported so far have been for exposure. The table below shows both accepted and denied claims.

We also capture the industry where the worker is employed, as classified by North American Industry Classification System (NAICS). The vast majority of claims are in health care industry, which includes assisted living facilities. The next highest industry is public entities.
