Under the new law, PPD ratings are on the basis of percent of the "whole person." PPD benefits adjust with annual changes to AWW. PTD and survivors' benefits are based on Average Weekly Wage (AWW) of injury year; TTD maximum applies to benefits paid during a fiscal year, thereby providing an escalator factor.

*For injuries from Jan. 1, 2002 through Dec. 31, 2004, the first 64 unscheduled degrees are paid at \$184.00 per degree; the next 96 degrees are at \$321.00 per degree; above 160 degrees the value is \$748.00 per degree. Scheduled degrees are paid at \$559.00 per degree. Degrees are not used for injuries on or after Jan. 1, 2005.

**Maximum possible benefit for PPD, including both Impairment and Work Disability. Maximum Work Disability rating is 142%.
