PTD and survivors' benefits are based on Average Weekly Wage (AWW) of injury year; TTD maximum applies to benefits paid during a fiscal year, thereby providing an escalator factor.

\*Maximum possible benefit for PPD, including both Impairment and Work Disability. Maximum Work Disability rating is 142 percent.

\*\*For injuries from Jan. 1, 2010, benefit for child with no surviving parent is increased to 4.35 x 66 2/3% AWW, while child is attending higher education, until age 23 or graduation.

\*\*\*For injuries from Jan. 1, 2010, through June 30, 2010, burial allowance is increased to 20 x AWW.
