\*Maximum possible benefit for PPD, including both Impairment and Work Disability. Maximum Work Disability rating is 142 percent.

\*\*Benefits for surviving children continue until age 18, or 23 if attending higher education. If there is no surviving parent, benefit is 4.35 x 66 2/3% AWW.
