## **Purpose of the Rate Area Findings Report Document**

This Rate Area Findings Report (formerly known as the Supplemental Report) has been produced to support making the transition from geographically grouping prices based on the current three subsidy rate areas to grouping prices in the clusters that appear to better represent the current market. This report describes how child care prices vary by age group, type of care, and Oregon's current subsidy rate areas. Analyzing data by the existing three rate areas allows us to compare 2022 market prices with the maximum payment rates currently used by the Oregon Department of Human Services (ODHS). This document presents the 2022 findings using the same three rate areas for all three types of care (A, B, C). For many years now, the price clusters defined by the use of statistical clustering no longer match the three rate areas identified in earlier studies. This report further illustrates that the three rate areas are no longer a valid representation of how market prices group geographically, as provider pricing practices have changed. This report is to be used as a tool alongside the 2022 Market Price Study Report, which uses statistical clustering to define price clusters across the state.

## **Historical Background on Rate Area Analyses**

In Oregon, prior market price studies were conducted approximately every two years from 1990 forward. All studies relied on data collected by Child Care Resource and Referral Agencies (CCR&R) and all but one involved analysis of data stored in the CCR&R database; the 1999 study involved a survey of providers drawn from that database. Since 1994 (with the exception of the 1999 survey) researchers have analyzed the data by zip code looking for price clusters. Through 2008 researchers found prices for centers, large home-based care, and small home-based care<sup>1</sup> to cluster into three groups known as rate areas.

In Oregon market price studies for 2010 and 2012, analyses of prices indicated that there were changes in how providers were pricing services and that the three clusters may no longer accurately describe prices. Analyses indicated that center and large home-based child care prices were steadily increasing and that prices of small home-based child care providers were stagnating. In addition, programs were increasingly moving into the highest rate areas or remaining in the current rate area, in part, due to an Oregon Department of Human Services policy that no zip code should move to a lower rate area. Additionally, higher zip code average prices for centers and large home-based care were sometimes pulling small home-based child care homes into a higher rate area. There were also signs that center and small home-based child care prices were not clustering in similar ways. These findings raised questions about whether or not the three rate areas were accurately describing prices in the child care market.

In analyzing the 2014 and 2016 data, a continuation of the trends observed in 2010 and 2012 data were found. Using guidance from a national study on market price surveys, we looked into alternative methods to identify zip code areas with similar child care prices. After careful consideration we decided to use a statistical clustering method that looks for groups or clusters that occur in the data and provides a systematic way to find the optimal natural breaks between groups. This method was used in the 2014, 2016, 2018 and 2020 Market Price Studies; and now again in this 2022 study. The findings from the 2022 analyses can be found in the 2022 Oregon Child Care Market Price Study.

## **Data Source**

This study includes child care facilities in the priced child care market. Given that almost all centers and small and large home-based care are captured in Find Child Care Oregon, the Child Care Resource and Referral (CCR&R) database, this database was used for the 2022 Market Price Study. Central Coordination managed a

<sup>1</sup> Home-based child care providers are typically identified by their regulatory status: a) small home-based providers are known as registered family child care, and b) large home-based providers are known as certified family child care. We use the terms small and large home-based care rather than the regulatory titles throughout this report. This version of the report includes license-exempt home-based providers who accept referrals from their local CCR&R and reported full time prices charged to families. A supplemental document is available upon request that shows the results restricting small home-based care to *only* licensed registered family providers.

data update process in which data on capacity and price by age group were collected from active Oregon child care facilities within a three-month period (October - December) to ensure all data were comparable and current. This included 4,780 facility records that were active as of December 2022. After facility records without price data and those that were not considered part of the child care market were eliminated, the final sample was 2,752 facilities including 1,045 (38%) small home-based care, 937 (34%) centers, and 770 (28%) large home-based care.

**Findings**

**Comparison of Rate Areas to Oregon Statewide Prices**

To test the validity of the three rate areas (A, B, C), we compared Oregon statewide prices to prices in the three rate areas. If the rate areas are valid, we would expect that, within care type and age group served, Area A prices should exceed the statewide price, Area C prices should be lower than the statewide price, and Area B rates should approximate the statewide price.

**Rate Areas and Statewide Prices by Child Care Slots**

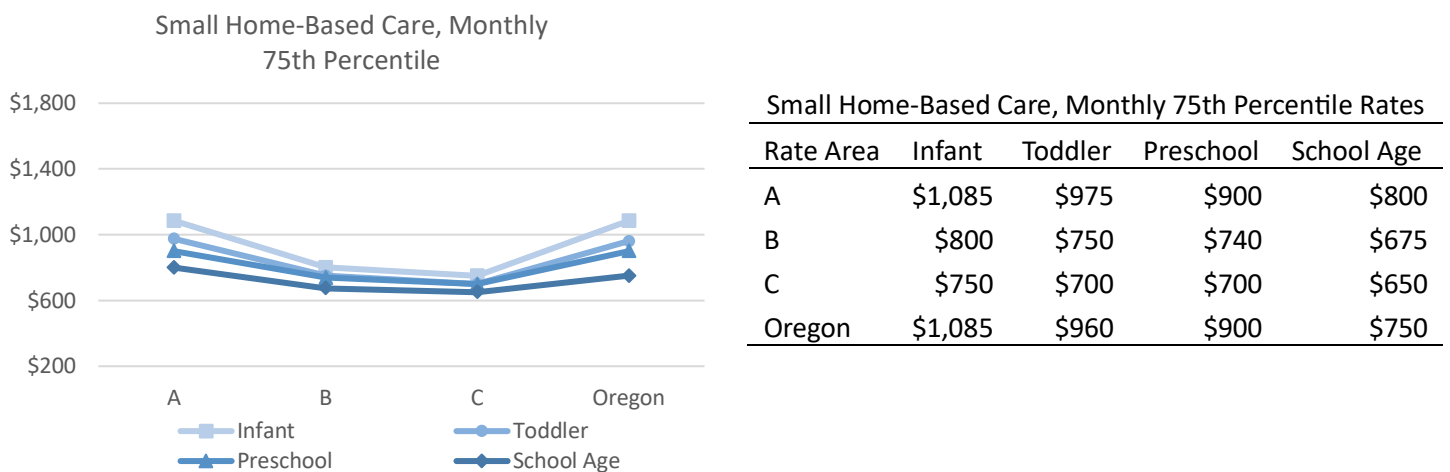
Figure 1 displays graphs comparing the 75th percentile monthly prices per child care slot across type of care and age group served. The graphs provide evidence that the three rate areas no longer accurately capture the distribution of prices due to a combination of changes in provider pricing practices and the practice of not allowing zip codes to move to a lower rate area.

Indeed, use of the three rate areas show:

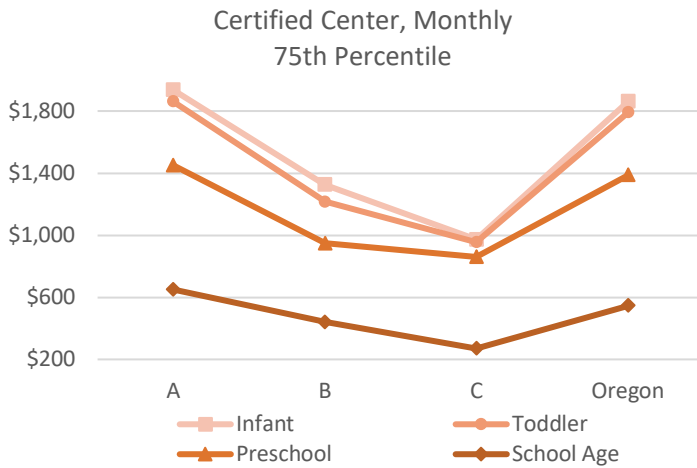
- (a) statewide prices more closely represent rate Area A than B for all types of care,
- (b) there is less distinction between the prices in rate areas B and C, especially for large and small home-based care.

One would expect there to be more distinction in the rate areas if they were accurately describing the price distributions across the state.

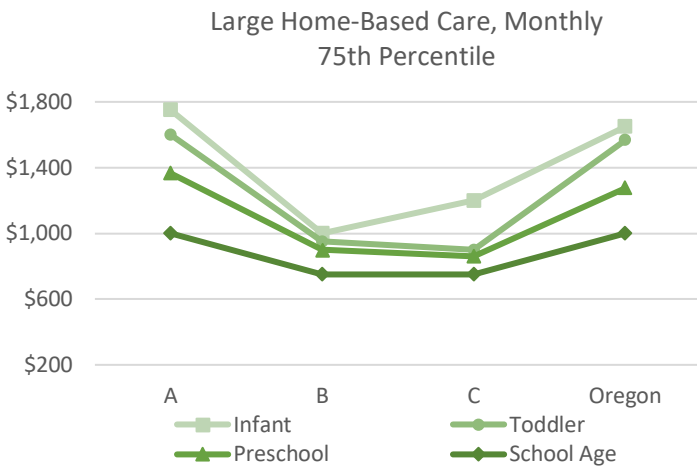
**Figure 1. Comparison of 2022 Rate Areas and Oregon Statewide Prices by Child Care Slots**

**Geographic Analysis of Rate Areas**

Overall, the geographic analysis described below shows that rate area prices continue to be lower in rural areas of the state and higher in the Portland metropolitan area, parts of the Mid-Willamette Valley, and parts of Hood River, Deschutes, and Jackson counties.

Summary of Geography for Rate Areas

- **Rate Area A** contains zip codes with some of the highest prices and has 58% of all child care facilities (3% more than in 2020). Area A includes the Portland metropolitan area, Mount Hood, Corvallis, Independence, Monmouth, Seal Rock, Eugene, Springfield, Ashland, Bend, and Gold Hill.
- **Rate Area B** has 31% of all child care facilities (3% less than in 2020), and includes the cities of Salem, Stayton, Astoria, Hammond, Coos Bay, Coquille, Lincoln City, Sweet Home, Sisters, Redmond, Medford, Roseburg, Albany, Woodburn, Halsey, Philomath, areas outside the Portland metropolitan area, and the Mid-Willamette Valley.
- **Rate Area C** includes all communities not in Area A or B, including most of Oregon’s rural areas. Rate Area C includes 11% of all child care facilities. The same percentage as in 2020.

For a complete list of hourly and monthly rates for each rate area and statewide by percentile, type of care, and age group, see [Table A](#) (Small Home-Based), [Table B](#) (Centers), and [Table C](#) (Large Home-Based). In addition, [Table D](#) presents the statewide 75th percentile full-time prices for child care slots by type of care and age groups served from 2000 to 2022.

### Accessibility Based on Subsidy Maximum Payment Rate

The state subsidy's maximum payment rate affects subsidy parents' access to all types of child care in the community. The Federal Office of Child Care defines the 75th percentile of the current child care market prices as the benchmark for equal access, and considers payment rates set at or above the 75th percentile as providing equal access<sup>2</sup>. In June 2022, the reimbursement rates were raised to align with the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile prices as estimated in the 2020 Market Price Study. In addition, starting in 2020, Rate Area C facilities are reimbursed using the Rate Area B maximum subsidy reimbursement rate. See Tables A-C for the maximum licensed payment rate by type of care and age group.

Using the maximum subsidy rate, we explored access in three ways:

- (1) percent of slots statewide that can be purchased at the maximum full-time subsidy rate.
- (2) percent of facilities with prices at or below the maximum full-time subsidy rate.
- (3) percent of facility care by zip code that can be purchased at the subsidy rate; this measure was created to determine if the amount of access varied by geographic location.

To answer these questions, toddler prices are used as they were found to be closest to the combined price, and most representative of all age group prices. Toddler prices were also used as the basis for grouping price data in previous studies.

### Percent of Slots that can be Purchased at the Maximum Full-Time Subsidy Rate

In Oregon, current licensed rate maximums<sup>3</sup> are adequate to purchase approximately 65% of toddler slots statewide. Of the 9,081 toddler slots in market care statewide, 5,906 are at facilities that charge prices at or below the current licensed rate maximums. This also varies by type of care with the current maximum rate able to purchase 68% of slots for small home-based, 62% of slots for centers, and 72% of slots for large home-based care.

The percent of slots that can be purchased with the value of ODHS maximum payment rates increased from 55% to 65% between 2020<sup>4</sup> and 2022. In 2020, of the 9,438 toddler slots in market care, 5,180 are at facilities that charge prices at or below the current licensed rate maximums. This also varied by type of care in 2020 with the current maximum rate able to purchase 64% of slots for small home-based, 51% of slots for centers, and 61% of slots for large home-based care.

**Percent of Facilities with Prices at or Below the Maximum Full-Time Subsidy Rate**

At a facility level, 72% of facilities offer toddler prices less than or equal to the licensed rate maximum. This also varies by rate area. As illustrated in the table below, potential access is higher in Rate Area C (80%) and lowest in Rate Area B (70%).

The percent of facilities offering toddler rates less than or equal to the licensed rate maximum increased from 64% to 72% between 2020 and 2022. This also varied by rate area in 2020 with potential access highest in Rate Area C (69%), followed by Rate Area A (65%), and lastly Rate Area B (60%).

**Percent of Facilities by Zip Code that can be Purchased at the Subsidy Rate**

Child care providers are divided into rate areas based on zip codes, see [Table E](#) for a complete list of rates areas by zip code. The following table provides the number and percent of zip codes by breakdown of the percent of facilities that charge at or below the licensed rate maximum. Financially, ODHS licensed rate maximums allow families access to greater than 75% of facilities for small home-based care in just over half (55%) of Oregon zip codes, for centers in two-thirds (67%) of zip codes, and for large home-based in just under two-thirds (63%) of zip codes. The ODHS licensed rate maximums are not adequate to purchase any small home-based market care in 12% of zip codes, center care in 9% of zip codes, and large home-based care in 9% of zip codes.

The number of zip codes for center and large home-based care is lower than small home-based care because a larger number of zip code areas have small home-based child care facilities than have centers or large home-based care.

## Conclusion

The high-level findings for this report are summarized below:

- The comparison of rate areas to statewide prices showed that statewide prices more closely represent rate Area A than B for all types of care. Also, there is less distinction between the prices in rate areas B and C, especially for large and small home-based care. One would expect there to be more distinction in the rate areas if they were accurately describing the price distributions across the state.
- Prices continue to be lower in rural areas of the state and higher in the Portland metropolitan area, parts of the Mid-Willamette Valley, and parts of Hood River, Deschutes, and Jackson counties.
- Current licensed rate maximums are adequate to purchase approximately 65% of toddler slots statewide with variation in access by type of care (62% of slots for centers, 68% of slots for small home-base, 72% of slots for large home-based care).
- Across facilities, 72% of facilities offer toddler prices less than or equal to the licensed rate maximum (up from 64% of facilities in 2020), however this percentage varies by rate area (72% of facilities in rate area A, 70% in rate areas B, and 80% in rate areas C).
- Within zip codes, the percent of facilities that can be purchased with the subsidy rate indicates that accessibility varies across zip codes. The percentage of zip codes where the majority (over 75%) of facilities charge at or below the subsidy rate varies by type of care. (For small home-based care, just over half (55%) of Oregon zip codes; for centers, two-thirds (67%) of zip codes; for large home-based care, just under two-thirds (63%) of zip codes).

This report further illustrates that the three rate areas are no longer a valid representation of how market prices group geographically, as provider pricing practices have changed. This report is to be used as a tool alongside the 2022 Market Price Study Report, which uses statistical clustering to define price clusters across the state, to inform decision making around rate setting in light of how prices vary by type of care and geography.
