

Baby Promise Program

Do you have a child under three years of age? Have you heard about Baby Promise? You may qualify for fully funded child care:

Baby Promise offers free, full-time, year-round, high-quality early care and education for eligible families in Oregon with children aged 6 weeks to 3 years.



Baby Promise is available through qualified local child care programs to families living in eligible regions. The regions include: Multnomah, Crook, Jefferson, Deschutes, Coos, and Curry counties, as well as serving Reedsport.

Baby Promise helps families choose a qualified Early Learning and Care Program that works for them by partnering with local home or center based providers. Baby Promise Providers with slots for eligible families provide free food and diapers to Baby Promise children while the child is in care.
