



IMPORTANT REMINDER

Lead Testing is Required Every Six (6) Years

Child Care providers must test all drinking water faucets or fixtures for lead at least once every six (6) years from the date of the last test. A drinking water faucet or fixture is anywhere you take water for drinking, cooking, preparing infant formula, or preparing food.

Analysis of water samples must be conducted by an ORELAP laboratory. See link below to find a list of these labs in the state of Oregon or search here: <https://orelap.state.or.us/searchLabs>. Results of testing must be submitted to the Child Care Licensing Division (CCLD) and shared with parents.

If your facility only uses bottled water (for all drinking, cooking, preparing infant formula, or preparing food), an alternative water source declaration form may be submitted instead of testing. CCLD recommends testing at least one faucet as a back-up.
