
When You Must Be Recorded

Requirements through the Child Care Licensing Division



Some types of child care are not required to be licensed with the Child Care Licensing Division (CCLD). If any of the following conditions apply to you, the type of care you provide may be required to be recorded as a program.

You must be recorded if:

- You are operating a preschool or school-age program that meets recording requirements. You will need to submit a recorded program application.
- You are operating a program that is for school-age children, is focused on a single enrichment activity and operates for no more than eight hours a week.
- You are operating a program that is mostly a group athletic or social activity and is sponsored by an organized club or hobby group.
