The company offers a fully subsidized, all zone Tri-Met pass to each associate. A \$30 monthly incentive is available to any employee who carpools, vanpools, bikes, walks or uses transit to commute. To receive an incentive, employees complete and turn in a commute log each month.

Bike racks, on-site showers and preferred parking for those who carpool and/or drive hybrid vehicles further encourage participation.

Norm Thompson's Trip Reduction Program reduces use of fossil fuels, reduces air pollution and minimizes traffic on the busy highways.
